It's **ADVENT!** And what great traditions our Catholic Church has! With Advent comes the Wreath bearing Four Candles that we light this season. According to dynamiccatholic.com, "As a Christian tradition, the wreath holds the four Advent candles. *The candles represent Jesus coming as the light in darkness*. One candle is lit each Sunday until all four candles are lit. As Christmas draws nearer, each



candle brings a little more light into the darkness. Sometimes a white candle is lit on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day to symbolize that Jesus is with us. This can be referred to as the "Christ candle."

The meaning of the candles is explained as such, according to mercyhome.org: "The first candle, which is purple, symbolizes hope. It is sometimes called the "Prophecy Candle" in remembrance of the prophets, especially Isaiah, who foretold the birth of Christ. It represents the expectation felt in anticipation of the coming Messiah. The second candle, also purple, represents faith. It is called the "Bethlehem Candle" as a reminder of Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem. Let us light our second candle!
