The Council of the City of Brundidge, Alabama held its' Organizational Meeting Monday, **November 3rd, 2025** at 3:00 o'clock p.m. at Brundidge Station at which time and place the following members were present: Mayor Boyd and Council members Shehane, Hall, Everett, Gaynor and Rodgers. Mayor Boyd called the meeting to order.

Mr. Gaynor moved the council approve Resolution No. 2026-03 which provides for the rules of procedure the council will operate under during this four year term. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Hall and by show of hands the vote was recorded as follows; voting yea, Shehane, Hall, Everett, Gaynor and Rodgers; voting nay, none.

Mrs. Rodgers moved the council table Resolution No. 2026-04 which establishes the council committees during this four year term. The motion was seconded by Mr. Gaynor and by show of hands the vote was recorded as follows; voting yea, Shehane, Hall, Everett, Gaynor and Rodgers; voting nay, none. This Resolution will be brought back up at the next regular meeting of the council.

Ms. Rodgers moved the council approve Resolution No. 2026-05 which designates the depositories of the city and approves payment of the re-occurring expenses of the city during this four year term. The motion was seconded by Mr. Gaynor and by show of hands the vote was recorded as follows; voting yea, Shehane, Hall, Everett, Gaynor and Rodgers; voting nay, none.

Mr. Everett moved the council approve Resolution No. 2026-06 which appoints Linda Faust as City Clerk for the term of office beginning November 3, 2025 through November 5, 2029. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Shehane and by show of hands the vote was recorded as follows; voting yea, Shehane, Hall, Everett, Gaynor and Rodgers; voting nay, none.

Mr. Gaynor moved the council approve Resolution No. 2026-07 which appoints Willie Wright as City Manager for the term of office beginning November 3, 2025 through November 5, 2029. Mayor Boyd moved the council approve Resolution No. 2026-10 to designate Byron Gaynor as *Mayor Pro Tempore* for the term ending November 5, 2029. Mrs. Hall moved to amend the motion and appoint Mrs. Rodgers as *Mayor Pro Tempore*. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Shehane and by show of hands the vote was recorded as follows; voting yea, Shehane, Hall, Everett, Gaynor and Rodgers; voting nay, none.

Mayor Boyd moved the council approve Resolution No. 2026-11 appointing Sgt. Kenneth Duncan as the interim Police Chief until which time the Police Chief is appointed. There being no second the motion failed as presented.

There being no further business to come before the council, Mrs. Rodgers moved the meeting be adjourned with a second by Mrs. Hall, all voted yea.
