CITY OF BRUNDIDGE RESOLUTION NO. 2025-09

SOUTHEAST CRESCENT REGIONAL COMMISSION, STATE ECONOMIC AND INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT (SEID) GRANT PROGRAM

To authorize the filing of an application to the Southeast Crescent Regional Commission (SCRC) under the State Economic and Infrastructure Development (SEID) Grant Program; to commit a local match for the project; and to authorize the Mayor of Brundidge to sign all documents related to the filing of the 2025 SCRC SEID Application.

WHEREAS, the Southeast Crescent Regional Commission (SCRC), established pursuant to the 2008 Farm Bill (Public Law 110–234, Section 379B), is a federal-state partnership created to address economic distress in parts of the southeastern United States and to foster economic development, improve infrastructure, and promote job creation; and

WHEREAS, the SEID Grant Program, administered by SCRC, provides funding assistance for basic public infrastructure, transportation improvements, business development, and other activities that support economic competitiveness in distressed counties and regions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Brundidge, acting by and through its City Council, proposes to apply for SEID funding to undertake critical improvements at the Brundidge Wastewater Treatment Facility, a project that will protect public health, strengthen local infrastructure, and support economic growth; and

WHEREAS, as part of the grant administration requirements, the City of Brundidge must designate an official to act as Financial Officer to provide fiscal oversight and compliance throughout the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRUNDIDGE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

- That Mayor Isabell Boyd is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application, with all required assurances and supporting documentation, to the Southeast Crescent Regional Commission for SEID Grant Program funds in the amount of \$532,000; and
- 2. That the City of Brundidge commits to providing a local cash match of \$532,000 to support the total project cost and ensure successful implementation; and
- 3. **That** Mayor **Isabell Boyd**, or her successor in office, is hereby designated and appointed as **Financial Officer** for the purposes of the SEID grant administration, and is authorized to make assurances, execute documents, and take any and all actions necessary to carry out the responsibilities of this role on behalf of the City.
