The Council of the City of Brundidge, Alabama met in regular session Tuesday, February 17<sup>th</sup>, 2026 at 6:00 o'clock p.m. at City Hall at which time and place the following members were present: Shehane, Hall, Everett, Gaynor and Rodgers. Mayor Boyd called the meeting to order.

The minutes for the February 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026 council meeting was presented and upon a motion by Mrs. Rodgers, second by Mr. Gaynor, with all voting yea, the minutes were approved as presented.

Mayor Boyd introduced the first reading of Ordinance No. 2026-01 regarding Brightspeed's Franchise Agreement with the City. This is a 30-year agreement and Brightspeed will pay the City five percent (5%) of its' local exchange access service Gross Revenue annually. A second reading of this Ordinance will be presented at the next council meeting.

Mr. Everett moved the council approve an agreement with S & P Communications to install (2) Commscope DB224 dipole antennas (1 on each side) on a 2 20' Rohn Towers on opposing sides of water tank located on South Main Street across from the high school. An 8 x 10 prefabricated building will be installed at the bottom secured to a concrete pad. The City will receive unlimited number of radio access and talk groups (channels) to the system, at no cost. Mr. Gaynor seconded the motion and by a show of hands the vote was recorded as follows, voting yea; Shehane, Hall, Everett, Gaynor, Rodgers and Boyd. Voting nay; none.

The City Clerk reviewed the FY2025 Audited Financial Report.
