WHEREAS, Southern Classic Food Group, LLC has established itself in the City of Brundidge for the manufacture, warehousing and distribution of food products and other goods necessary for the food products industry; and

WHEREAS, the Company has made application to the City and requested that the City grant, in respect of the Project, abatements of certain State and local taxes, in accordance with and to the extent permitted under the Tax Incentive Reform Act of 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Company in its' application stated an investment of \$14,150,000.00 would be invested for the purchase of additional manufacturing machinery and or equipment: now

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Brundidge, Alabama that the Mayor and City Manager be and hereby are authorized to execute said Abatement Agreement with Company; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the Council also approves the Application to Granting Authority for Abatement of Taxes which will exempt the Company from non-educational Sales and Use Taxes in the approximate amount of \$117,500.00 for City of Brundidge, 284,500.00 for the State of Alabama and \$208,000.00 for the Pike County Commission.
