Also, the city requested an additional tree be removed due to the fact it was dead and would create a curve in the trail. That cost was \$2,000. Total additional cost to the project is \$3,500.

Mayor Boyd opened the meeting with a public hearing regarding a request from Rev. Samuel Green to have his property located on 128 Galloway Road from B-1 (Neighborhood Commercial) to R-2 (Medium Density Residential). There being no questions or comments, Mayor Boyd closed the public hearing.

The minutes for the November 7th, 2023 council meeting was presented and upon a motion by Mr. Gaynor second by Mrs. Hall, with all voting yea, the minutes were approved as presented.

Meg Stroh requested the council approve three art events to be held on the Bass House in April 2024 and the third Thursday in June and October of 2024. Mr. Gaynor moved to approve the request with a second by Mrs. Hall. With all voting yea, the motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the council, Mrs. Hall moved the meeting to be adjourned with a second by Mr. Gaynor.
