The Council of the City of Brundidge, Alabama met in regular session October 15th, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. at City Hall at which time and place the following members were present: Councilmembers Baxter, Griffin, Ross, Gaynor and Foster. Mayor Boyd called the meeting to order.

The minutes for the October 1st and 11th, 2019 council meetings were presented and upon a motion by Mrs. Ross second by Mr. Gaynor, with all voting yea, the minutes were approved as presented.

Mayor Boyd opened the meeting with a public hearing to discuss the application for a Land and Water Conservation Fund grant. Mrs. Ashton Hutchison, Community and Economic Development Director South Central Alabama Development Commission, was present to explain the projects eligible for this grant and to answer any question those in attendance may have. After Mrs. Hutchison's presentation, Mayor Boyd opened the floor for questions or comments. Theresa Trawick commented she would like the parks pet friendly. Michael Green posed the question regarding the type of equipment being considered. Mrs. Hutchison explained the project is still in the planning stages so the type of equipment will be considered during that time.
