

Ordinance No. 2020-02

Tupper Lightfoot Memorial Library

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Brundidge, Alabama, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person who has been issued a library card by the Tupper Lightfoot Memorial Library, the government and supervision of which is vested in the Library Board Of the City of Brundidge pursuant to the Code of the City of Brundidge, after receiving written notice as herein provided, to fail or refuse to return or cause to be returned any book, periodical, recording or other material checked out from the Tupper Lightfoot Memorial Library, together with all overdue assessments or late charges, in compliance with the rules of the Board with respect, thereto.

Section 2. The failure of any person checking out any book, periodical, recording or other material from the Tupper Lightfoot Memorial Library to return same within the time required by the rules of the Board shall be prima facie evidence of intent not to return the said book, periodical, recording or other material to the Tupper Lightfoot Memorial Library by the holder of the primary card to which the same is charged.


Section 3. Before any holder of library card of the Tupper Lightfoot Memorial Library shall be charged with any violation of this section, such holder shall first be written notice that checked-out library material is overdue. Such final notice shall be conclusively presumed to have been given when said notice is deposited with the United States Postal Service and addressed to such holder at the address shown upon the membership records of the Tupper Lightfoot Memorial Library.

Section 4. If fees are under \$25.00 but over \$5.00, the patron is blocked from circulation unless at least 50% of the bill is paid each time. If fees are over \$25.00, a patron is blocked from circulation until fees are paid. Names of persons who have accounts of over \$25.00 for non-returned library materials and/or fines are given annually to the City of Brundidge Administrative Assistant for collection.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
