

**CITY OF BRUNDIDGE**  
**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-05**  
**2020 CENSUS GRANT PROGRAM**

To authorize the filing of an application to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs, 2020 Census Grant Program; to commit a local match for the project; and to authorize the Mayor of Brundidge to sign all documents related to the filing of the Gant Program Application.

**WHEREAS**, the 2020 Census Grant Program was created through a \$1,000,000 appropriation to the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA) and the funds enacted as a part of the 2019-2020 Education Trust Fund serve as a vehicle to support the accurate count of the Alabama Counts! 2020 Census campaign; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brundidge, acting by and through the City Council proposes to apply for 2020 Census Grant Program funds to support a media campaign and community outreach program designed by the City to increase responses in an identified low response census tract; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Brundidge as a recipient of these funds is required to designate and appoint a Financial Officer to perform certain duties in the administration of said grant.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the City of Brundidge, as follows:

**THAT**, Isabell Boyd, Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute and submit an application with appropriate assurances to the State of Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs, requesting 2020 Census Grant Program funds in the amount of \$5,642; and

**THAT**, the City of Brundidge hereby commits to provide cash resources to complete the project in the amount of \$5,642 for the local share of the project; and

**THAT**, Isabell Boyd, or the current Mayor, be and is hereby designated and appointed as Financial Officer and is directed and empowered to make necessary assurances and to perform on behalf of the City of Brundidge, those acts and assume such duties as are consistent with said position.
