FY2022 RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM
RESOLUTION NO. 2023-02

WHEREAS, the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) was created in 1998 and is funded through the U.S. Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration to provide grant assistance to State and Federal agencies and local units of government for the acquisition and/or development/improvement of recreational trails and trail related resources; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Boyd has received notification from Mr. Kenneth W. Boswell, Director for the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs, informing the City of Brundidge has been selected to participate in the Recreational Trails Program for Ramage Park to improve and expand the recreational trail and support the facilities; and

WHEREAS, under terms and provisions of Recreational Trails Program, the City of Brundidge as a recipient of these funds is required to designate and appoint a Financial Officer to perform certain duties in the administration of said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City of Brundidge, as follows:

THAT, Mayor Isabell Boyd and City Council hereby accepts the financial assistance granted from the Alabama Department of Economic Affairs in the amount of \$200,000 from the Recreational Trail Program and authorized Mayor Boyd to execute all necessary documents relating to this project ; and

THAT, the City of Brundidge hereby commits to provide cash and in-kind resources to complete the project in the amount of \$144,795 for the local share of the project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City of Brundidge understands and comply with all rules and regulations of the Recreational Trails Program, applicable Executive Orders and all state laws that govern the grant applicant during the performance of the project.
