Signature Waiver Letter Notification of Invasive Treatment for 2020

April 21, 2020

Dear BASS LAKE Property Owners:

The BASS LAKE ASSOCIATION Board of Directors has decided to continue our Curly-leaf Pondweed treatment program again this year. Herbicide will be applied in selected areas shortly after the ice goes out in Bass Lake. Our decision to continue treating this invasive is based on the results of a recent Delineation Survey that was completed by Freshwater Scientific. This year we have received a permit to treat approximately 5 acres near the western shore of the small and large bays.

Like last year, the Minnesota DNR has granted us a waiver of the requirement to obtain signatures of approval of owners of lake-shore property. Instead, we are notifying property owners of the treatment through various form[s]. This letter is one form that we are using to notify property owners. We will also provide notification in the Spring 202 Bass Lake Association Newsletter and a notice on the Bass Lake Assn Website.

With regard to the treatment for this year, which will occur during the month of May 2020, please be advised of the following:

- The target species for this treatment is Curly-leaf Pondweed
- The method of control will be a spray application of either Endothall.
- Property owners can request that herbicide not be applied adjacent to their property.
- Notices that treatment has occurred will be placed in prominent locations along the shoreline immediately after treatment.
- Residents should respond no later than May 15th if they choose not to have herbicide applied in front of their property.

If you **do not want** treatment to occur in front of your property, you may opt out of this treatment by simply notifying Jim Dvorak, your current Bass Lake association President.
