

**EATON TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONTHLY MEETING
August 1, 2023**

The regular monthly meeting of the Eaton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Kenny White on Tuesday, July 5, 2023.

Present were Chairman Kenny White, Vice- Chairman Abe Kukuchka and Supervisor Robert Pitcavage.

Minutes from the previous meeting were distributed in draft form. With no corrections needed, Supervisor Pitcavage made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Chairman White.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Financial report was noted

ZONING OFFICER REPORT:

Mr. Patton issued two permits- one to a smoke shop in the Weis Plaza and a second to T Mobile. Also noted – the Ranwood / Geisinger subdivision was approved.

VISITORS AND GUESTS:

Denise Robinson was present to share concerns about unsafe traffic conditions on Frear Hill and Goble Hill. People are driving on the wrong side of the road. Roadmaster White concurred and will investigate possible line painting and future road widening. She also inquired about the possibility of storage units being constructed- Mr. Patton provided the zoning regulations for such a structure.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Mr. Pitcavage made a motion last month to investigate installation for the solar speed signs- North East Signal came in at \$4,006. Final decision will be made next meeting. Mr. White explained that the plow needs to be replaced; Bradco gave a quote of \$9,400- and the pipe on Horizon Lane needs to be done- as soon as blueberry season has finished. Also, the yellow trucks clutch is beyond repair. Mr. Kukuchka made a motion to approve said projects with a second by Mr. Pitcavage.

NEW BUSINESS:

The upcoming Fall Convention was noted, DEP and Assessor's documents were reviewed. The County Planning documents were explained by Mr. Patton, the Supervisors approved. The intersection of Goble Hill, Sandbank and Route 29 was discussed. Paving costs approximately \$300,000 per mile, and pipes need attention; some belonging to PennDOT. Mr. Pitcavage noted that he will not be on the ballot in November. Mr. Kukuchka made a motion to retain Diana Patton as treasurer via Numbers Made Easy Consulting, and no longer Stonehouse. Mr Pitcavage seconded.

Checks were signed.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:50 pm by Chairman White, second by Supervisor Kukuchka.
