EATON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONTHLY MEETING March 7, 2023

The regular monthly meeting of the Eaton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Kenny White on Tuesday, March 7, 2023.

Mr. Patton shared the Zoning Officers report; there was one permit for Dymond Terrace. Mr. Patton also received training on Floodplain Management and addressed the written complaint for a Keelersburg Road resident. Stephen Menn was appointed as the solicitor for the Zoning Hearing Board.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Supervisor Pitcavage brought up, from January's meeting- the signs for the school bus stop, and the culvert on Frear Hill, that should be jetted. Mr. Patton will ask about a service provider. Chairman White will look into the issue.

NEW BUSINESS:

Assessors changes and tax transfer were discussed. Mr. Pitcavage will call Chris Gates about an upcoming Municipal road traffic count on Cedar Ledge and Horizon. Mr. Pitcavage reported on the EMS meeting he attended. There was an increase in calls, that average three hours and funds are an issue. The Comm Center cannot impose a tax, but the Townships can. 20% of paid subscription were sent out-\$1,200 of \$9,000. They suggested a tax mil- and can do 1.5. The ambulance company wants to meet with each Township. He also mentioned that Williams 811 class was rescheduled. Mr. Patton noted that he sent out an invoice for KBA for \$870 to residents of Church Road, and also hand delivered it.

Checks were signed.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:45 by Supervisor Pitcavage, second by Chairman White.
