

**EATON TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONTHLY MEETING
February 6, 2024**

The regular monthly meeting of the Eaton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Vice-Chairman Bob Pitcavage on Tuesday, February 6, 2024.

Present were Vice-Chairman Bob Pitcavage and Supervisor Jim Greenley. Chairperson Kenny White was absent.

Minutes from the previous meeting were distributed in draft form. With no corrections needed, Supervisor Pitcavage made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Supervisor Greenley.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Ms. Patton discussed the Liquid Fuels issue. It should be resolved by a meeting on February 26th, which she, Secretary Harvey and the available Supervisors will attend.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT:

Mr. Patton shared the Zoning Officers report; there were two permits; one structure/ deck repair, and one trailer demo.

VISITORS AND GUESTS:

Jason Racht was in attendance.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

The other solar speed sign is set to be installed on a pole that prepared for it by Citimark Credit Union. Mr Greenley suggested the use of a contractor to have it done in a timely manner. The Bridge Light project was discussed- a year extension has been granted. Four bus stop signs were procured from the school district- to be installed in the townships in places resident's request. There was a question of speed bump installation in Eaton Hills- but the liability of it was decided to be preventative.

NEW BUSINESS:

Theresa Rule and Bonnie Jayne were appointed to the vacant auditors' positions; motion by Vice Chair Pitcavage, second by Mr. Greenley. An ad denoting that and other meetings was approved. Signups for the Northeast Regional Contractors and Engineers Workshop was discussed. Assessor's and back taxes documents were reviewed. LTAP training needs survey was noted.

Checks were signed.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:50 by Vice- Chairman Pitcavage, second by Supervisor Greenley.
