EATON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONTHLY MEETING July 5, 2023

The regular monthly meeting of the Eaton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman Kenny White on Tuesday, July 5, 2023.

Present were Chairman Kenny White and Supervisor Robert Pitcavage; Supervisor Abe Kukuchka was absent.

Minutes from the previous meeting were distributed in draft form. With no corrections needed, Supervisor Kukuchka made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Supervisor Pitcavage.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

The financial report was accepted as positive. There was an increase in Act 13 deposits- from\$83,495 to \$98,215.64. Mr. Pitcavage asked a question about the profit/ loss percentage on the financial report. Eric Davis, auditor for the township, presented his report- which after signing would be submitted to DCED. Most items remained static. It was noted that the biggest change for next year will be no ARP funds, as the second larger amount has been deposited. The townships operating costs would be covered for a year and Mr. Davis found no issue with policy. Mr. White thanked him for the job done. He then motioned to accept the results, with a second by Mr. Pitcavage.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT:

Mr. Patton was noted to be very busy.

VISITORS AND GUESTS:

Mr. Davis of Ginader and Jones was present.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

The pipe near Route 29 is included in cleaning by PENNDOT. Ambulance service from Tunkhannock was unavailable for an emergency in Thurston Hollow. Motion by Bob Pitcavage to get quotes for the solar sign installation- second by Chairman White.

NEW BUSINESS:

Secretary Harvey attended the County's Hazard Mitigation Meeting and made available the worksheets provided. The many Assessor's changes were noted. The paperwork received from Coterra Water Services was just normal procedure.

Checks were signed.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:55 pm by Chairman White, second by Supervisor Pitcavage.
