EATON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONTHLY MEETING June 1, 2021

The regular monthly meeting of the Eaton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman White on Tuesday June 1, 2021.

Present were, Chairman Kenny White, Supervisor Abe Kukuchka, Supervisor/Road Master Paul Rowker, Secretary Jennifer Harvey, and residents, the Coolbaughs.

Minutes from the previous meeting were distributed in draft form. With no corrections needed, Chairman White made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Supervisor Kukuchka.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Chairman White motioned to accept the Financial Report, Supervisor Rowker seconded.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT:

Supervisor made a motion to accept the report, and Chairman White seconded.

VISITORS AND GUESTS:

The Coolbaughs inquired about dust control. Supervisor Rowker assured hem it would be done as soon as the weather and delivery allowed, possibly by Wednesday. The ditches were then discussed.

NEW BUSINESS:

The Joint Municipal Agreement was signed. The invoice for the Walmart appraisal was reviewed and approved for payment. Chad Patton was appointed the next Zoning Officer, and asked only for a 2-drawer filing cabinet, which was approved. The offer from Exeter on the Dodge truck was accepted, and the pertinent papers allowing Mr. Rowker to conduct the sale were signed. Assessors' changes and the approval of the Greenley minor subdivision were noted. Supervisor Rowker noted that the paving projects would be advertised next week, and that the health insurance was being shopped by a local company. He also noted that the park lease agreement included a ten-year option, and that the county did pay for tree removal. The Supervisors agreed on the lease.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:27 by Chairman White, seconded by Supervisor Kukuchka.
