

**EATON TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MONTHLY MEETING
March 1, 2022**

The regular monthly meeting of the Eaton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Chairman White on Tuesday, March 1, 2022.

Present were, Chairperson Kenny White and Supervisor/Roadmaster Paul Rowker. Supervisor Abe Kukuchka was absent.

Minutes from the previous meeting were distributed in draft form. With no corrections needed, Chairman White made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Supervisor Rowker.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

Accepted as positive.

ZONING OFFICER REPORT:

Supervisors noted that the report looked good.

VISITORS AND GUESTS:

Residents Dave and Tammy Williams were present.

NEW BUSINESS:

Employees wages were noted as \$18 an hour for part time road workers, and a 3 percent increase for Jason Racht and Jennifer Harvey. Two grants were received for Seneca Park- \$4,000 from the visitors Bureau for new signage and a \$5,000 Marcellus Fund mini-grant. The mini grant will be used for lighting and security or a lawn mower as needs are assessed. The Fish Commission will be stocking on Monday. Documents denoting the transfer of the Meade pipeline were reviewed. Treasurer Patton explained that there is \$146,000 in liquid fuels for summer road projects, and that the audit conducted by the state is nearing completion. Roadmaster Rowker suggested Thurston hollow and Jenks road needed a new coat of blacktop. Ms. Patton also mentioned the additional revenue from Marcellus Shale. The extension for the ARLE grant for bridge lights has been extended. Grants are opening provided by the state for \$25,000- \$1,000,000, funding infrastructure and property purchases. Assessors' changes were noted. The supervisors broke for an executive session. It was mentioned by Supervisor Rowker that the flood property on Church Road had issues with deed, but demolition on the unencumbered "hotel" was nearing.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:34 by Chairman White, seconded by Supervisor Rowker.
