EATON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MONTHLY MEETING May 4, 2021

Assessors' changes were noted. An agreement with TASD was agreed upon and signed, to share fees and costs in the case of Walmart's Assessment Appeal. A letter from PA State Historic Site Preservation was read. The packet from the planning commission for Dymond Terrace was discussed and sent back with questions. The Zoning Officer will look at Overfields. Fords Construction permit was discussed. A fire Hydrant will be installed using grant money on Hunter Highway. Supervisor Rowker laid out the intended road projects, which the treasurer did approve. Bob Baker inquired about the current progress with Roadside Rest, with Supervisor Rowker stating that the project is still waiting for final approval, and Supervisor Kukuchka adding that it remains open for fishing.
