

The following rules will govern all Metro Baseball Play-Off games:

1. Game Length

- All games will be 6 innings in length, 3 run inning rule with the 6th inning open.
- o During round-robin play the home team will be decided by coin flip.
- An approximate 2-hour time limit per game. The first inning after the 1.5-hour mark will be called the open inning and that inning will be played to completion. This will apply to all games, except the Finals, which will be played to completion. In the event of a time stoppage the final score will revert back to the last completed inning.

2. Line-Ups & Player Participation

- o All players listed in the line-up must be included in the batting order.
- Each player must play a minimum of 3 innings per game.

3. Pitching Rules

- o **18U:** Maximum **9 total innings**, with a maximum of **3 innings per game**.
- o **15U:** Maximum **8 total innings**, with a maximum of **3 innings per game**.
- o 13U: Maximum 7 total innings, with a maximum of 3 innings per game.
- o **11U:** Maximum **6 total innings**, with a maximum of **2 innings per game**.

4. Reporting Requirements

- All scorers and pitchers used in each game must be reported to the scheduler immediately following the game.
