Join our seasonal summer day camp team and apply by March 29, 2025, to work at one of over 21-day camp sites. The Los Angeles County Department of Parks and Recreation is offering an 8-week ESTEAM Camp throughout Los Angeles County Parks. The camp connects children ages 6-11 to the outdoors, encourages them to explore early career pathways, builds self-confidence and an understanding of ESTEAM topics, and inspires them to take action to improve their natural environment. Campers will learn and discover through group games, arts and culture experiences, guest speaker series and countless outdoor field trips and adventures. The camp uses various technology platforms to expose children to robotics, coding and gaming, and engineering projects.

Qualified candidates must be available to work the full eight-weeks of camp from June 16 through August 8 and work a Monday thru Friday schedule. Actual schedule hours vary based on positions. Qualified candidates must be available to attend CPR/First Aid and pre-summer training from May 27 thru June 13. These are seasonal summer positions only.

HOURLY RATE: \$28.32

Qualified candidates must be 25 years of age at the time of appointment, have 2 seasons of leading/administering a school-age summer camp, and possess a bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited college or university. The Day Camp Director is responsible for ensuring the following: camps adhere to all Public Health Safety requirements, the supervision of staff and participants, prepares for and carries out ESTEAM curriculum, and leads caregiver engagement efforts. This position works Monday thru Friday from 8 am to 5 pm and hours may be extended on field trip days.
