



Wakeboard Selection / Qualifying Criteria

Maximum 30 Athletes (15 Men & 15 Women)

- 1. Selection spots are allocated to countries with the best team overall results at the 2024 IWWF World Wakeboard Championships;
- These <u>countries</u> will use their discretion to enter riders on the "Preferred Riders" list (male/female). If a country's designated rider declines participation or is unavailable, the next country on the list will be given the spot, or another rider from the countries that can enter riders from both genders (at the discretion of IWWF's selection committee);
- 3. Riders not appearing on the list of "Preferred Riders" must be approved by the IWWF's selection committee prior to being entered;
- 4. A country is only permitted to enter a maximum of three (3) riders;
- 5. If a country is allocated more than one spot, both a male and female rider must be entered;
- Riders must have participated at the 2024 IWWF World Wakeboard Championships (exception for injured riders with medical certificates - they must have participated in the 2022 IWWF World Wakeboard Championships);
- 7. Participation at the last IWWF Regional Championships or participation at their last National Championships is mandatory (participation in one event is sufficient; participation in both events preferred);
- 8. Preference will be given to IWWF World, IWWF Regional and National Champions;
- 9. 2 x Wild Cards available (Male & Female) for the host country (China) riders to be approved by IWWF;
- 10.2 x Wild Cards available (Male & Female) for the IWWF
