## **MOANA FESTIVAL & MEDIA**

Auckland's maritime history stretches back centuries, deeply entwined with the city's identity. From the early Polynesian navigators to the European settlers, and hosting the America's Cup, Auckland has always been a hub of seafaring activity. This spirit lives on today, as the city boasts more boats per capita than anywhere else in the world, earning its proud nickname as the "City of Sails".



We are proud to announce that the 2025 University Worlds has partnered with Auckland's development agency (Tataki Auckland Unlimited) and is now part of the Moana Festival for 2025.

#### THE MOANA FESTIVAL

The Auckland Moana Festival is a celebration of this enduring maritime legacy, offering a plethora of events and activities that highlight the city's connection to the sea. Based in the Viaduct, just a few minutes' walk from the official accommodation at the Heritage Hotel, the festival offers a unique blend of tradition, culture, and modern entertainment.

## **TRAVEL & LOGISTICS**

Public Transport in Auckland is the easiest method to get from site to hotel. We recommend using Uber or Auckland Trains (<a href="www.aucklandtransport.co.nz">www.aucklandtransport.co.nz</a>) to get to site each day. There are 2 train stations a 10 minute walk to the site (not with equipment).

All transport is at the teams cost. Transport for officials will be managed / provided by the event.

## 3-Event Bags to Site

The AWSC will be providing a barge across the lake for ski gear avoiding the access stairs at the AWSC. The barge will be operating from 7am to 6pm daily from the 17<sup>th</sup> of February.

The drop point for the bags to site is here: Orakei Basin Car Park, 228 Orakei Road, Remuera, Auckland 1050. The transport provider will contact us to have the barge ready for your arrival on site.

## **ON SITE REGISTRATION**

Registration will be at the Auckland Water Ski Club buildings from 9am to 5pm from the 22-25 February. On the 25<sup>th</sup> we will be finishing registration at 3pm prior to the Opening Ceremony. There will be no registration available at the Hotel.

If you have ordered event clothing and selected the Delivery to Hotel option, this will be available at check-in at the Hotel.









Prior to registration, you must have provided the following:

## REMINDER: VISA ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

## REMINDER: BIOSECURITY REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW ZEALAND

New Zealand has very strict biosecurity controls in place at the border to protect its unique environment and primary industries. These controls are taken very seriously with all bags screened at the border. Failure to comply with the requirements will result in items being removed either permanently and destroyed, or for lengthy cleaning protocols.

- All water ski equipment <u>must be clean and dry</u> before arrival. Check inside wetsuits, boots and gloves for moisture, weed or lake debris and clean where necessary.
- Clean and check all ski bags of any grass or bugs and clean any shoes that may have any mud / dirt on the soles.
- Do not bring food items into NZ unless <u>commercially packaged</u>, <u>unopened</u> and <u>clearly</u> identifiable to border agencies. Auckland is extremely multicultural so many products from overseas are available in stores in the city.









## **FAMILIARISATION & TRAINING**

The AWSC <u>strongly recommends</u> on site familiarisation pre the event in all 3 disciplines due to saltwater, multiple course options and the tight entry to some courses. Due to the increased number of entries, we also **recommend** arriving in New Zealand prior to official familiarisation to ensure you have enough time on the water.

Note: unofficial training and practise will be conducted in a different manner to other world titled events. <u>Teams will not be able to block book time slots.</u> This is mainly due to the fluctuating weather conditions that Auckland city can experience and living with a maritime weather pattern.

All practice will use a 2023 Nautique 200 (6.2 Litre).

Official Familiarisation and the tournament will use the event boat(s), 2024 Ski Nautique (6.2 litre).

## There are 3 periods of training available:

- 1: Unofficial Practice: prior to the 19th of February booked via AWSC's booking system.
- <u>2: Tournament Practice:</u> between the 19<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of February inclusive.
- 3: Official Familiarisation: 24th and 25th of February.

# **UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE (prior to the 19<sup>th</sup> of February)**

On-site training is available at the AWSC's usual non-member rate (currently \$80NZD per set) via the Auckland Water Ski Club's booking system (HelloClub).

This system operates on a first-come, first-served basis. Bookings can be made <u>from 7am NZ time</u>, <u>2 days prior to your desired booking slot</u>. Ski tows can be paid individually, or credit added to your HelloClub account to minimise bank fees. Note you are unable to book consecutive ski tows for an individual skier and bookings can be cancelled up to 4 hours pre your ski – full terms are on the booking portal.

# **TOURNAMENT PRACTICE (19th to 23rd February)**

Due to the weather conditions in NZ, we will be scheduling practice to align with the best conditions for each event and course. Usually, we start early with Jump before the sea breeze kicks in, followed by Slalom, then Tricks.

The approximate timings are likely to be:










- Jump from 7.00am till 10.00am
- Slalom from 10.00am 3.00pm
- Trick from 3.00pm 7.00pm

Please note that the site is saltwater, and has produced top performances, but it can take a few sets for athletes to get used to. If we are unable to cope with the demand for training, an alternate site will be offered, however this will be on fresh water outside Auckland.

Team managers will receive a WhatsApp message (don't forget to register) the day prior advising of the next day's schedule. The running order will be calculated on a first in first service basis and we ask all managers to register their training requirements on the following link: https://forms.office.com/r/01zTK2Hd28

Do not forget to select the button to "Save the response" so you can adjust the request if necessary. Please do not create duplicate submissions.



All bookings will be handled according to the order they were received, and we will attempt to ensure all skiers requesting practice are provided suitable opportunity.

Payment for training sets (\$80NZD / \$50USD) can be made on the day by credit card (prior to taking the set) or your HelloClub account (for those that have set this up).

## **OFFICIAL FAMILIARISATION**

Official familiarisation will follow standard IWWF rulebook protocols and will be administered by the Chief Judge. The rates for official familiarisation are \$80 NZD (approx \$50USD) per set. All sets will be towed by the official towboat and will follow the Chief Judge instruction.

#### **OFF SITE TRAINING**

It is strongly recommended that skiers train on site prior to the event, however for those wanting more training, there are other off-site options within 1-2 hours' drive. ## **BOOKING UNOFFICIAL PRACTICE VIA HELLOCLUB (OR CREATING AN ACCOUNT)**


SECTION ONLY RELEVANT FOR THOSE BOOKING SKI TOWS PRIOR TO THE 19TH FEBRUARY, OR WANTING TO SET UP AN ACCOUNT FOR CREDIT PAYMENTS ON SITE DURING THE TOURNAMENT.

There are 3 steps to booking pre-event training as outlined in the following sections.

If team managers are managing all pre-event training, they should create an account on the system. If skiers are booking independently or would like to purchase items on site via credit (see section of this document on Cashless payments) they will also need an account.

## STEP 1: Creating Your Profile Online

Create a Profile on the AWSC's booking System (HelloClub) by using the following link:

A membership will be automatically assigned to you through the process and you will create some login details to access your account which allows you to see / pay for your bookings.

Add a Credit Card to your profile and select to store the card details for future payments. A credit card is required to create bookings.

## STEP 2: Create Your Ski Tow Bookings


Inside HelloClub, you can use the left-menu to select **Bookings** and then on the top of the screen ensure **UniWorlds** is selected.












Select your time-slot for bookings and complete the steps to review and pay for your booking slots.

## **ENTERTAINMENT EVENING – 28th FEBRUARY**

On Friday the 28<sup>th</sup> we will be hosting an entertainment evening with show skiing, food trucks on site and live music. We will also be hosting an unofficial 'Flip-Off' event with prizes for the winning athlete(s).

The Flip-Off is a fun tournament and is purely an opportunity to engage the spectators at the entertainment evening in some of the more dynamic aspects of our sport. The rules and boat for this event are deliberately different from the UniWorlds to ensure that there is no unfair advantage to skiers who may be competing over the following weekend.

#### **Format**

- Each skier will be granted one 20 second pass to complete as many flips as possible (tricks will be scored in the normal manner).
- The 8 skiers will be cut to the top 4 in semi-final then the top two skiers in the final.
- Prizes will include a cash prize and a joy ride in Mig Fighter Jet over the beautiful Coromandel Ranges
- The organizers reserve the right to auction off passenger rides in the tow boat.

## **Entry Requirements**

- The top eight ranked trickers that enter the event will be eligible to ski (selected from the IWWF world ranking list).
- If a skier elects not to enter this event, the place will be offered to the next highest ranked skier on the IWWF ranking list.

## **Towboat**

So as not to conflict with the Tournament, we will use the AWSC's Nautique 200 towboat for this event. This will be confirmed at the Team Managers Meeting.

#### **Prizes**

There will be a range of prizes for the traditional score /winning and "crowd favourite" entrant Most importantly, you will have the glory of being the very first Moana Festival Flip-Off Champion.
