Driving Local Economic Growth

Community events create value far beyond the activities that take place inside the event gates.

The inaugural Central Texas BBQ Roundup brought thousands of visitors to Central Texas, creating opportunities for local businesses while showcasing the people, products, and organizations that make our region unique.

Throughout the event, attendees supported local hotels, restaurants, fuel stations, retail businesses, and service providers. Competition teams traveled from across Texas, purchasing lodging, food, fuel, ice, supplies, and other goods and services within our communities.

The event also provided valuable exposure for 86 local businesses, vendors, exhibitors, and food vendors, creating opportunities to engage directly with thousands of potential customers while building new relationships throughout the region.

Combined with sponsorship investments, in-kind contributions, charitable partnerships, and local business participation, the inaugural Central Texas BBQ Roundup generated more than \$209,000 in total community investment.

Economic growth is not measured solely in dollars. It is measured by new customers gained, partnerships formed, businesses strengthened, and the confidence to continue investing in the future of Central Texas.

That is the lasting value community events can create when people choose to invest in something bigger than themselves.

Celebrating BBQ Excellence

Central Texas is widely recognized as the heart of Texas barbecue tradition. Shaped by generations of pitmasters, tradespeople, travelers, and early Czech and German influences, the region's barbecue heritage has become part of the story Texas shares with the world.

The Central Texas BBQ Roundup was created to honor that legacy while building a championship competition worthy of the place that helped define it.

As an IBCA-sanctioned championship competition, the inaugural Central Texas BBQ Roundup welcomed 100 championship BBQ teams competing for more than \$28,000 in prize money across 7 competition categories. These competitors traveled from across Texas, bringing visitors, supporting local businesses, and helping establish the Roundup as a premier destination for championship BBQ competition.

The quality of competition was evident throughout the weekend. Grand Champion Michelle Martinez of AMP Cookers earned the top honor at the inaugural Central Texas BBQ Roundup, securing a coveted invitation to compete at the BBQ World Cup in Las Vegas, the first championship event featuring a \$1 million prize purse.

While champions are recognized on stage, every competition team contributed to the event's success. Their commitment to excellence helped create an unforgettable experience for spectators, elevated the reputation of the Central Texas BBQ Roundup, and laid the foundation for a competition that teams will look forward to returning to year after year.

By celebrating BBQ excellence, we are preserving Texas tradition, honoring the pitmasters who carry it forward, and building an event that showcases the very best of Central Texas.

The Central Texas BBQ Roundup was honored with a Texas House Resolution presented by State Representative Hillary Hickland, recognizing the event as a fitting celebration of the smoked delicacies that are such an integral part of Texas culture.



Healing Heart Rescue Roundup

Strengthening the People Who Dedicate Their Lives to Saving Animals

The Healing Heart Rescue Roundup was created to do more than help animals find loving homes.

It was created to strengthen the network of people and organizations who dedicate their lives to protecting them.

In its inaugural year, 31 animal shelters, rescue organizations, veterinarians, trainers, advocates, and animal welfare partners came together from across Central Texas. While the event celebrated successful adoptions, it also accomplished something far more significant.

For many participants, it was one of the few opportunities they had to step away from the daily challenges of animal rescue and spend time with others who truly understand the work they do.

Throughout the day, they exchanged ideas, shared experiences, built new partnerships, and encouraged one another. They connected with prospective volunteers, foster families, donors, and adopters while educating thousands of attendees about responsible pet ownership and the critical role these organizations play in our communities.

Together, they provided:

- 32** pets adopted into loving homes
- 48** free vaccinations
- 70** free microchips with lifetime registration
- ✓ Free nail trims, ear cleanings, and pet wellness services
- ✓ Education promoting responsible pet ownership
- ✓ New opportunities for volunteers, foster families, and donors to become involved

The Healing Heart Rescue Roundup demonstrated that when animal welfare organizations work together instead of separately, their collective impact reaches far beyond what any one organization could accomplish alone.

It wasn't simply an adoption event.

It became a community dedicated to healing broken hearts—both human and animal.
