(A) GAME STOPPED IN TOP OF THIRD WITH RED LEADING 1-0. <i>(Game should be resumed at point it was stopped)</i> (SUSPENDED)	NO
(B) GAME STOPPED IN THE MIDDLE OF FIFTH INNING WITH RED LEADING 2-0. <i>(Game should be resumed at point it was stopped as blue must bat to be a regulation game.)</i> (SUSPENDED)	NO
(C) GAME STOPPED AFTER FIVE INNINGS WITH SCORE TIED 2-2. <i>(Game should be resumed at point it was stopped.)</i> (RESUMED)	NO
(D) GAME STOPPED IN MIDDLE OF SIXTH INNING WITH RED LEADING 3-2. <i>(Because blue has not batted in sixth inning, the game reverts back to the last full complete inning with the score tied 2-2, and when resumed, the game will begin in the top of the sixth at the point it was stopped with the red leading 3-2)</i> (RESUMED)	NO
(E) GAME STOPPED AFTER SIX INNINGS WITH BLUE LEADING 4-3. (COMPLETE)	YES
(F) GAME STOPPED IN MIDDLE OF SEVENTH WITH RED LEADING 5-4. <i>(Because blue has not batted in seventh inning, the game reverts back to the last complete inning and blue won 4-3. (Rule 5, Sec. 4a).)</i> (COMPLETE)	<input checked="" type="checkbox"/> YES
(G) GAME ENDED AFTER SEVEN INNINGS WITH RED LEADING 5-4. (COMPLETE)	YES
