Genesis 5:1-2

When God created mankind,
He made them in the
likeness of God. He created
them male and female and
blessed them. And He
named them mankind, when
they were created.

Genesis 5:3-4

When Adam had lived
130 years, he had a son
in his own likeness, in
his own image and he
named him Seth.

After Seth was born,
Adam lived 800 years
and had other sons
and daughters.

Altogether Adam lived
a total of 930 years
and then he died.

2. Establishing a pattern

Adam lived, had children, he toiled, then died.

Genesis 5:6-8

When Seth had lived 105 years, he became the father of Enosh. After he became the father of Enosh, Seth lived 807 years and had other sons and daughters. Altogether Seth lived a total of 912 years and then he died.

Genesis 5:9

When Enosh had lived 90 years he became a father of Kenan. After he became the father of Kenan, Enosh lived 815 years and had other sons and daughters. Altogether Enosh lived a total of 905 years and then he died.

Genesis 5:12-14

When Kenan had lived 70 years he became the father of Mahalalel. After he became the father of Mahalalel, Kenan lived 830 years and had other sons and daughters.

Altogether Kenyan lived a total of 910 years and then he died.

Genesis 5:15-17

When Mahalalel had lived 65 years, he became the father of Jared. After he became the father of Jared, Mahalalel lived 830 years and had other sons and daughters. Altogether, Mahalalel lived a total of 895 years and then he died.

5:18-20

When Jared had lived 162 years, he became the father of Enoch. After he became the father of Enoch, Jared lived 800 years and had other sons and daughters.

Altogether Jared lived a total of 962 years and then he died.

Ecclesiastes 1:2

Genesis 5:21-24

When Enoch had lived 65 years, he became the father of Methuselah. After he became the father of Methuselah, Enoch walked faithfully with God 300 years and had other sons and daughters.

Altogether, Enoch
lived a total of 365
years. Enoch walked
faithfully with God,
then he was no more,
because God took
him away.

65 years old when he
becomes a father.

300 years walking
faithfully with God.

365 years old when God
took him away.

1. He didn't always
walk faithfully with God.

2. This implies that
becoming a father
maybe flipped the
switch for him.

Hebrews 11:5-6

By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found because God had taken him. Now before he was taken, he was commended as having pleased God.

And without faith, it is impossible to please Him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who seek Him.
