Genesis 5:9 When Enosh had lived 90 years he became a father of Kenan. After he became the father of Kenan, Enosh lived 815 years and had other sons and daughters. Altogether Enosh lived a total of 905 years and then he died.

Genesis 5:12-14 When Kenan had lived 70 years he became the father of Mahalalel. After he became the father of Mahalalel, Kenan lived 830 years and had other sons and daughters.

Altogether Kenyan lived a total of 910 years and then he died.

Genesis 5:15-17 When Mahalalel had lived 65 years, he became the father of Jared. After he became the father of Jared, Mahalalel lived 830 years and had other sons and daughters. Altogether, Mahalalel lived a total of 895 years and then he died.
