

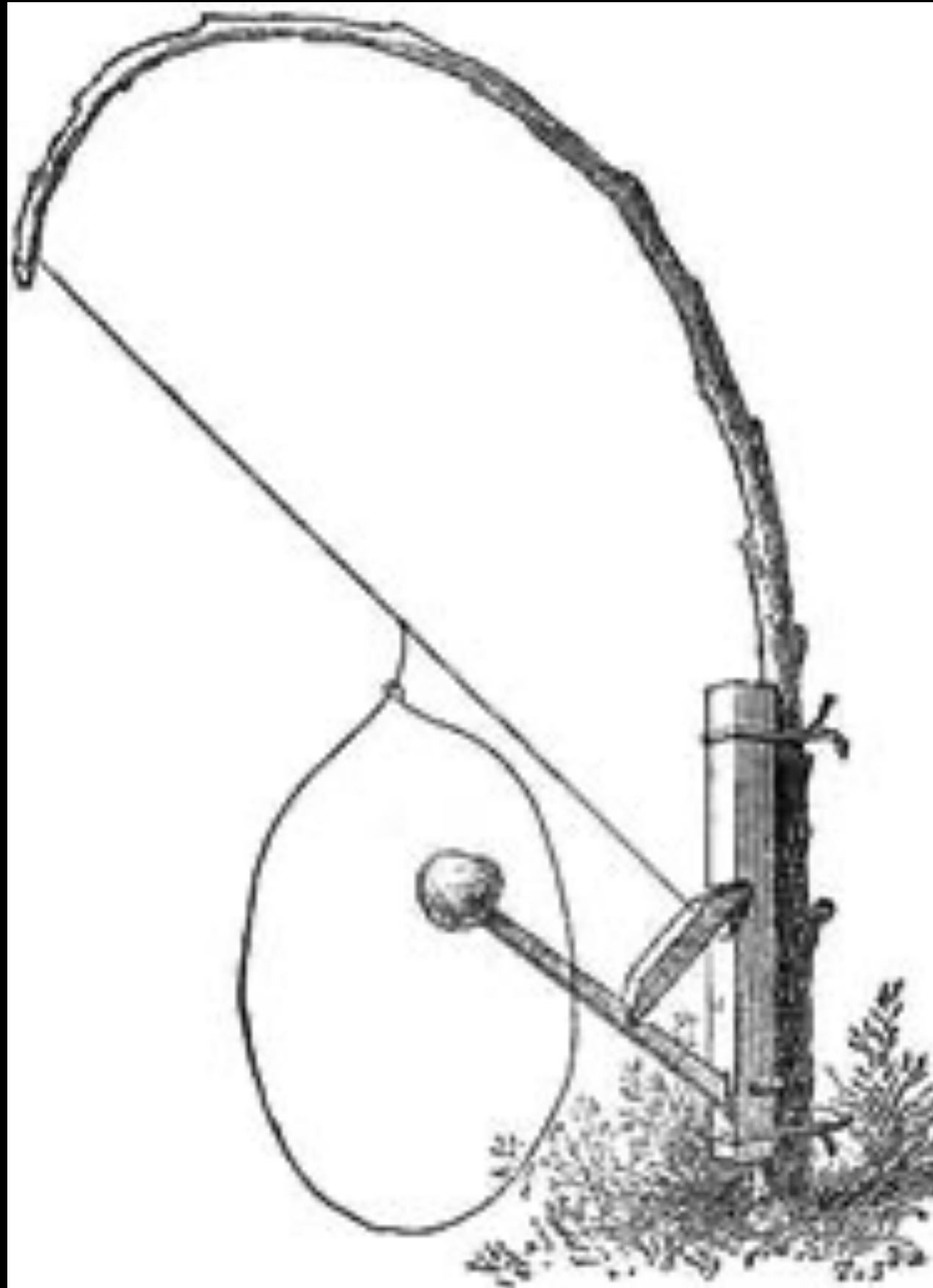
Sitting at the Feet of Jesus
