Philippians 2:5-8

Rather, he made himself
nothing by taking the very
nature of a servant, being
made in human likeness. And
being found in appearance
as a man, he humbled
himself by becoming
obedient to death — even
death on a cross!

Matthew 20:25-28

Jesus called them to Him and said, “You know how the kings of the nations show their power to the people. Important leaders use their power over the people.

It must not be that way
with you. But whoever
wants to be great
among you, let him care
for you. Whoever wants
to be first among you,
let him be your servant.
