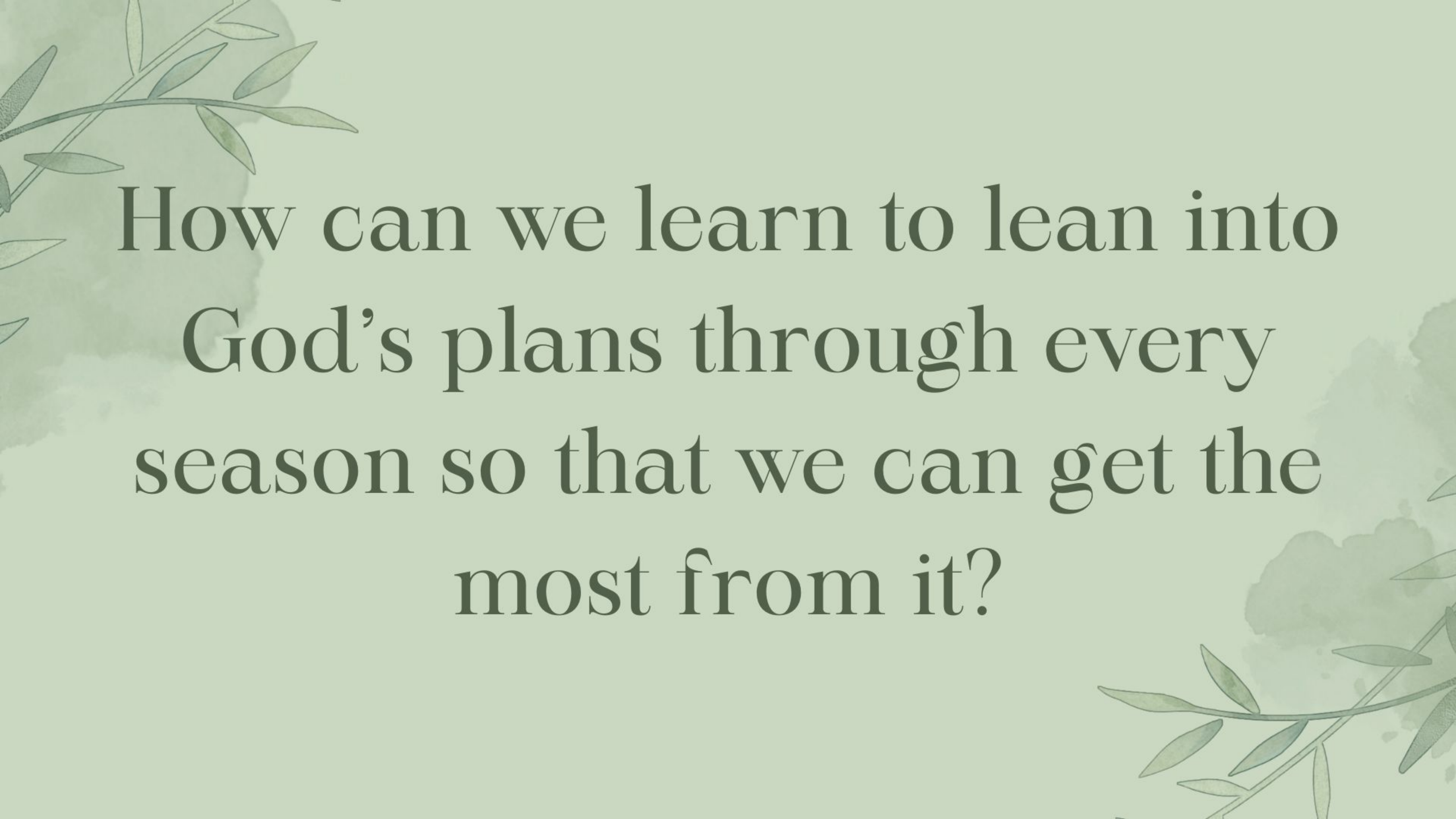

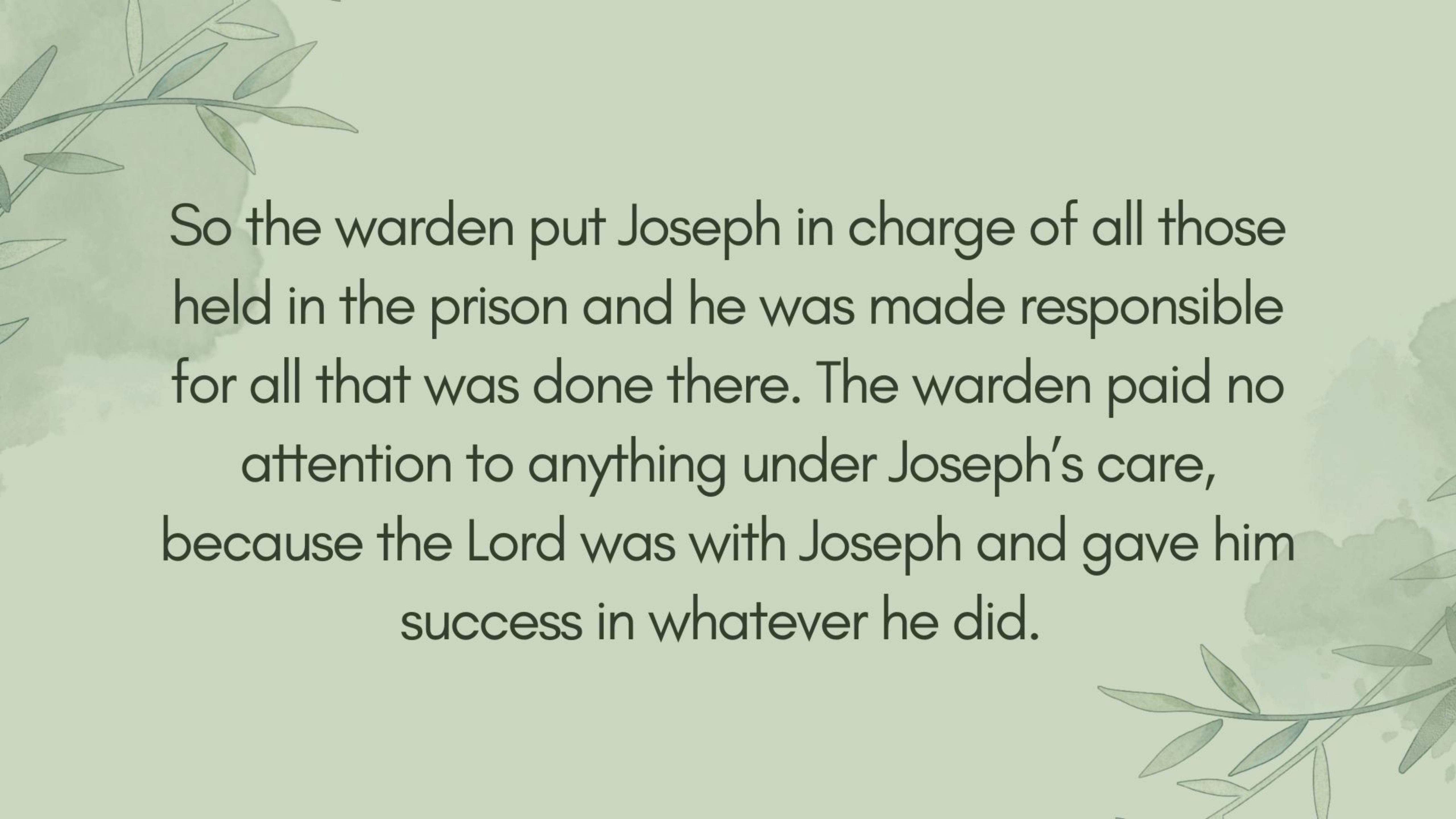

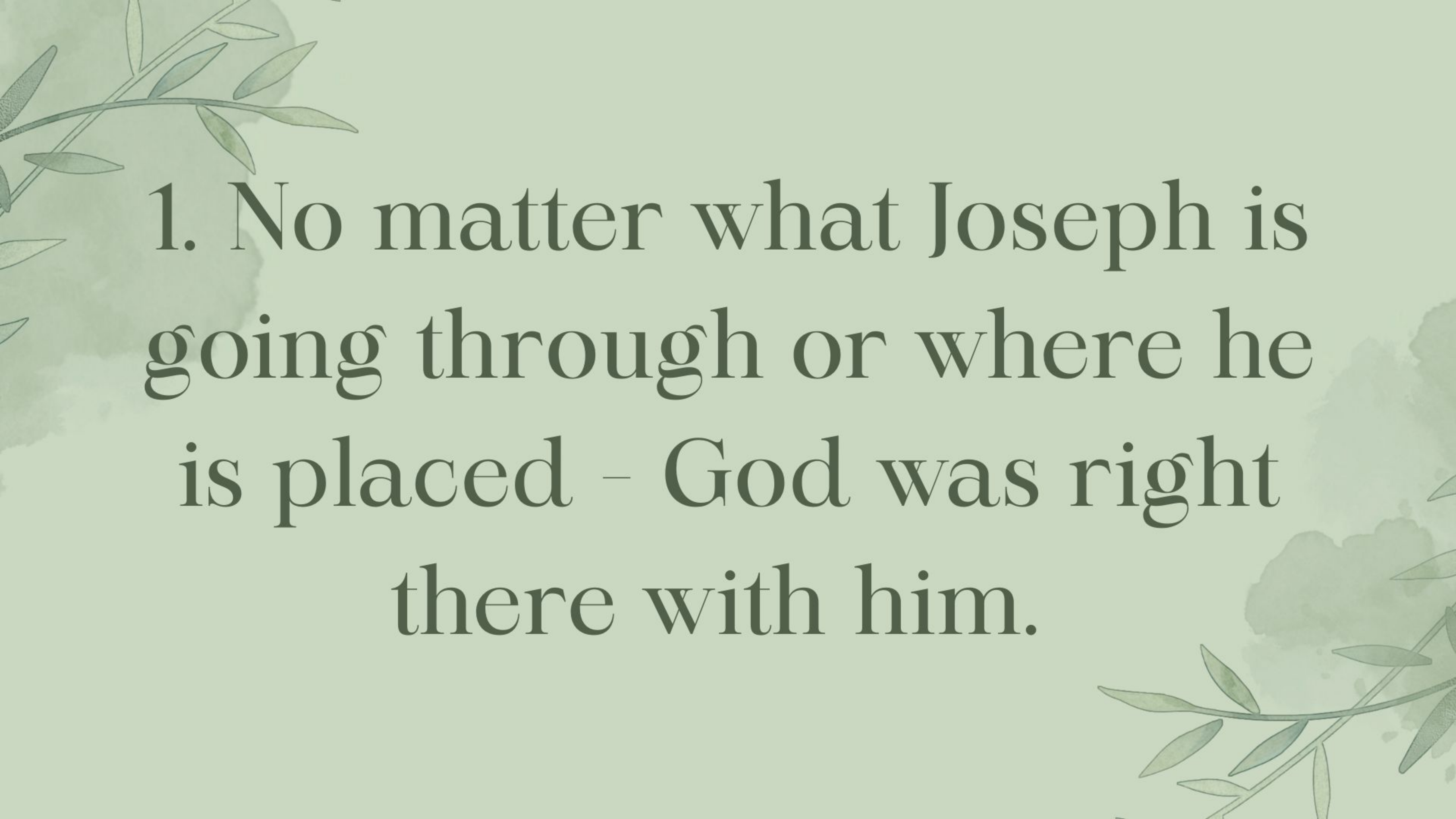
Genesis 39:20-23

But while Joseph was there in the prison, the Lord was with him; he showed him kindness and granted him favor in the eyes of the prison warden.

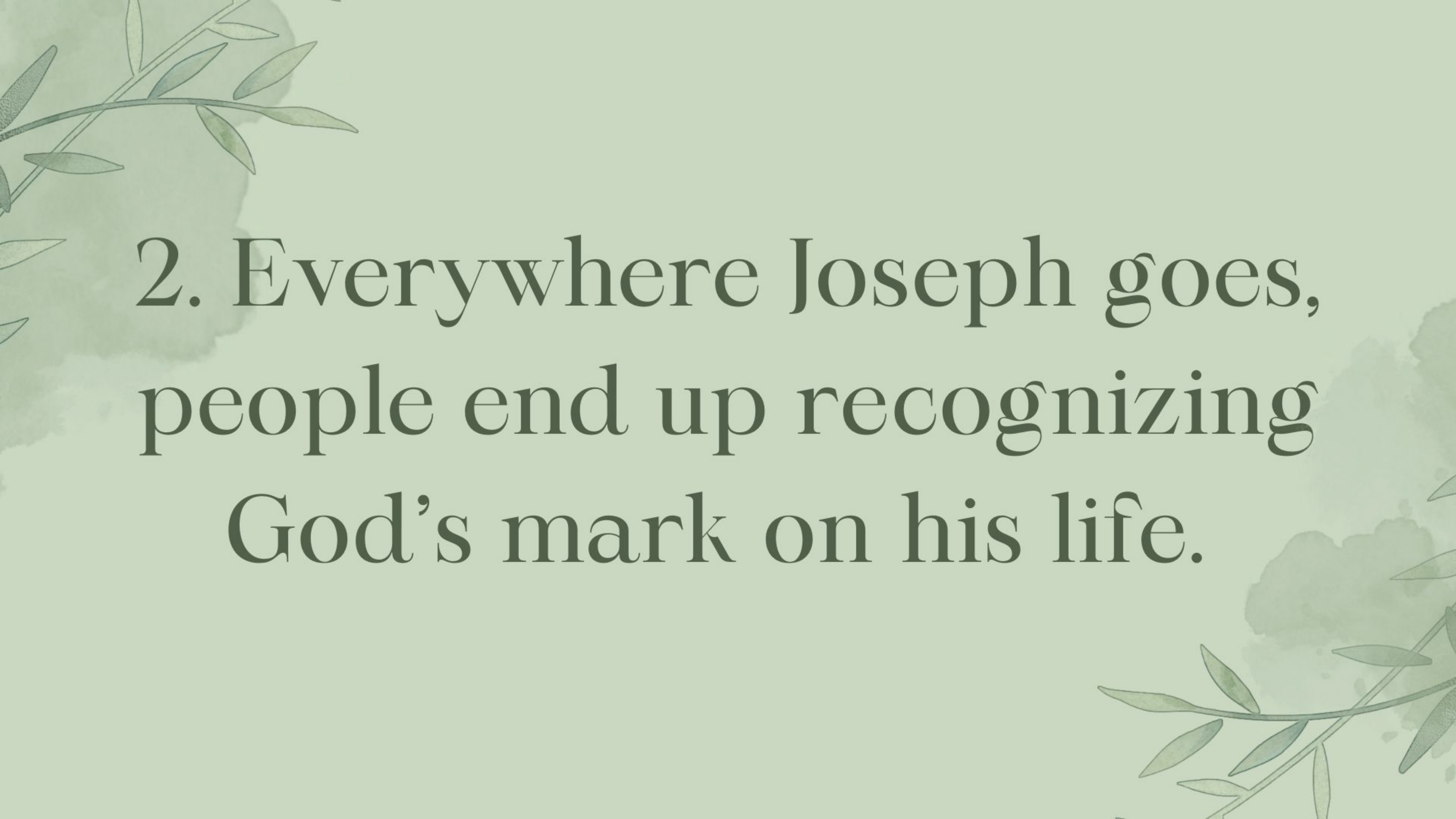

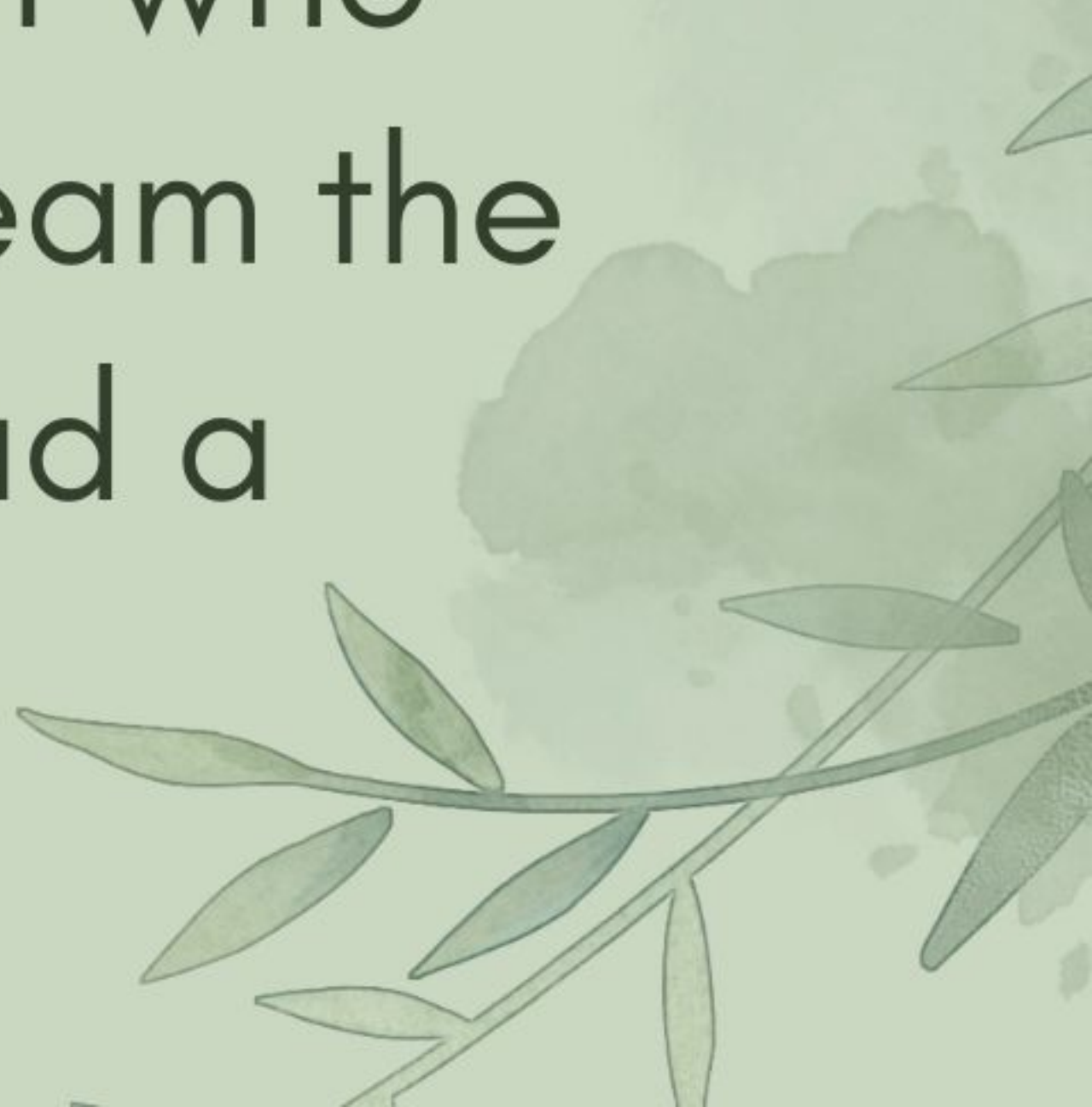

Planting is a Process

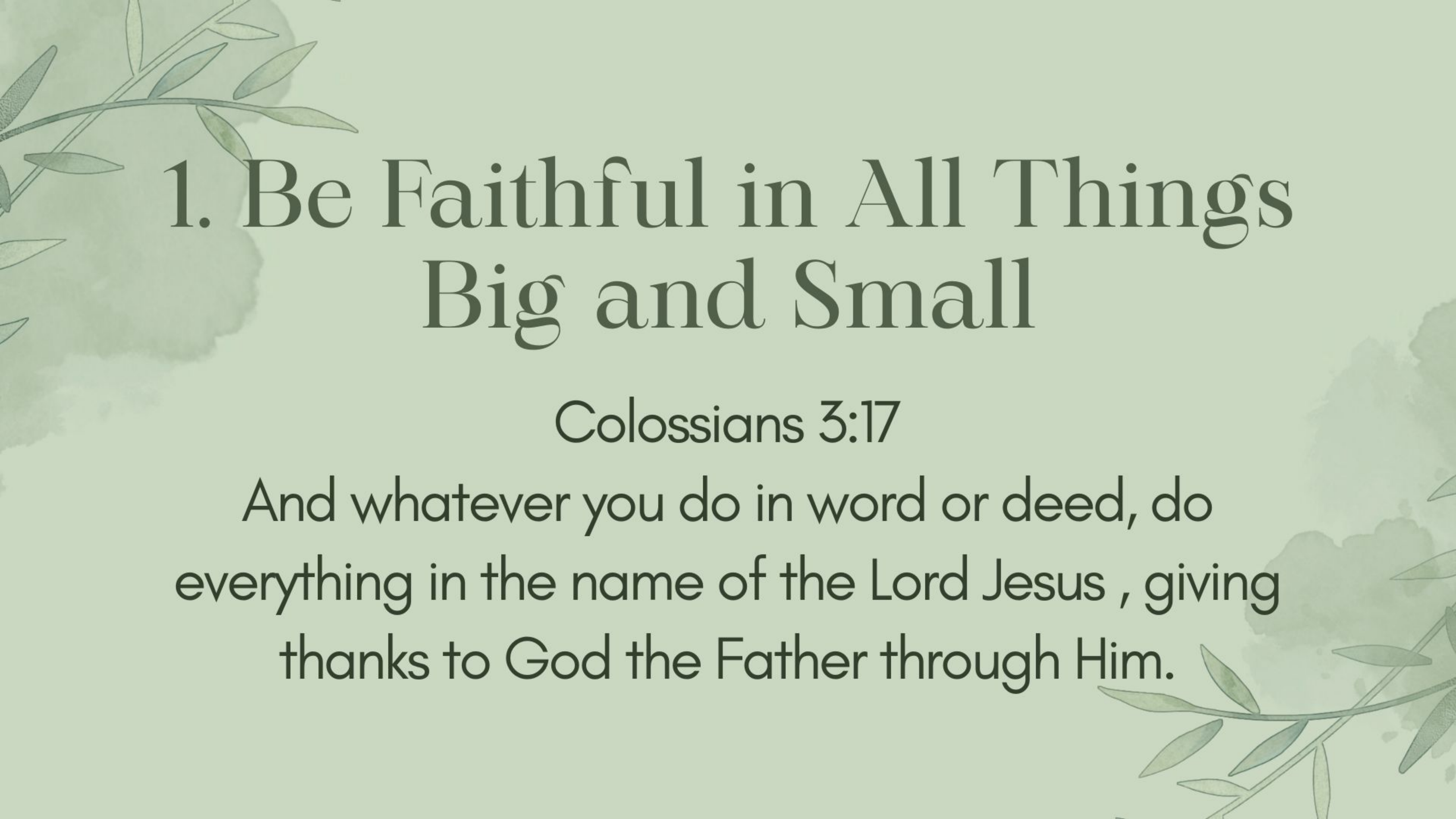
1. Breaking up the soil.

thanks to God the Father through Him.

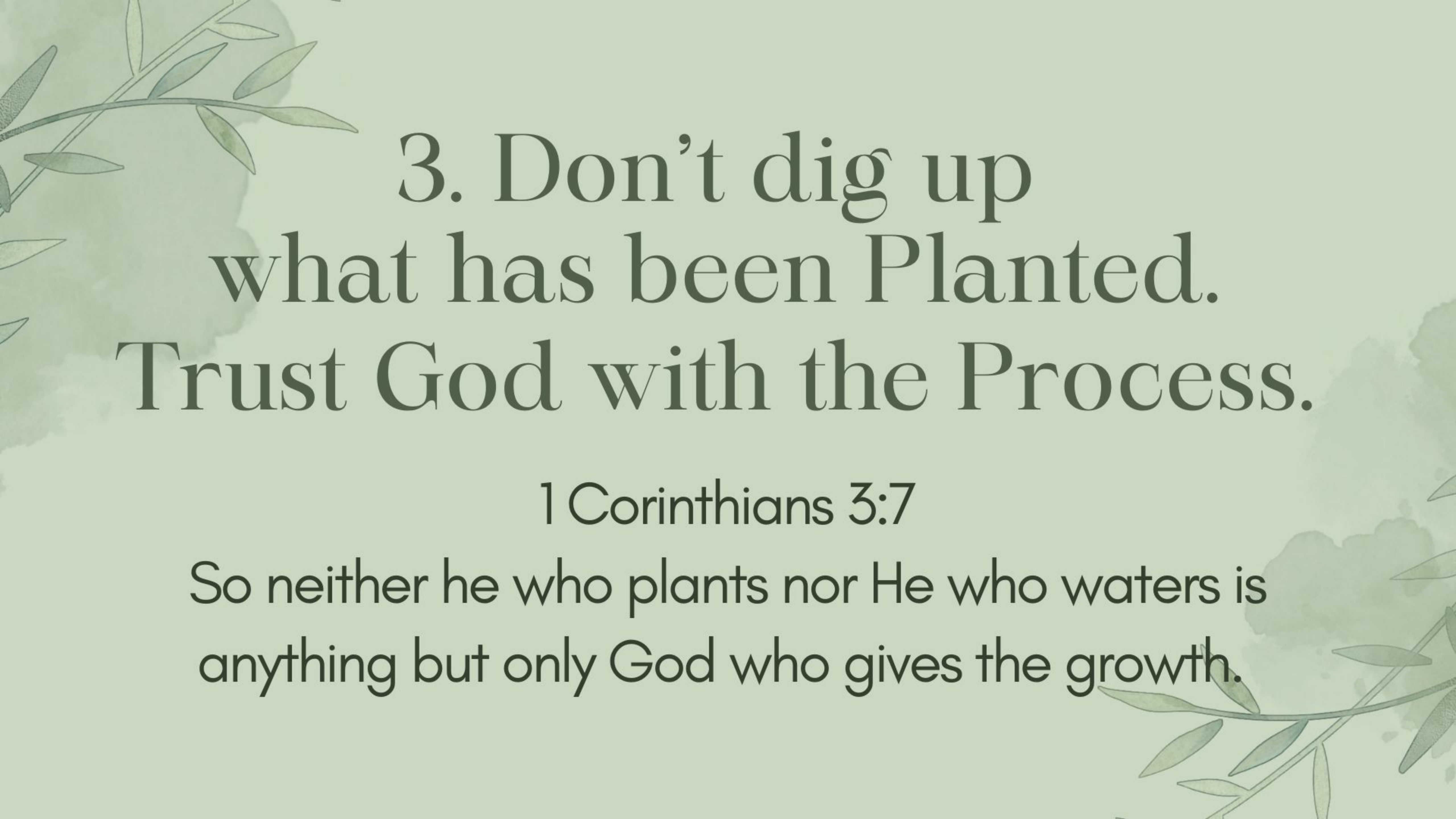


2. Sow Wisely

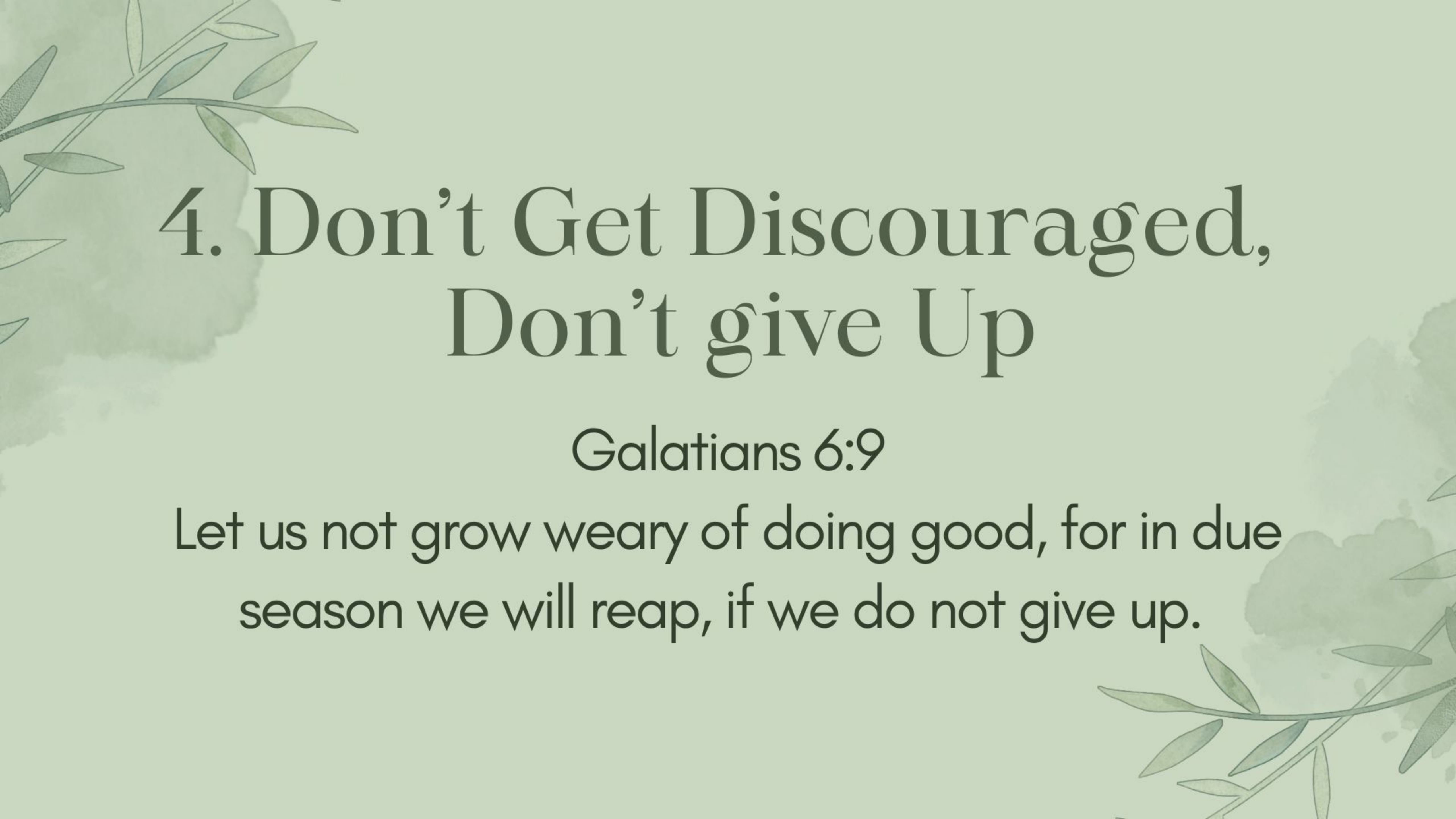




3. Don't dig up what has been Planted. Trust God with the Process.

1 Corinthians 3:7

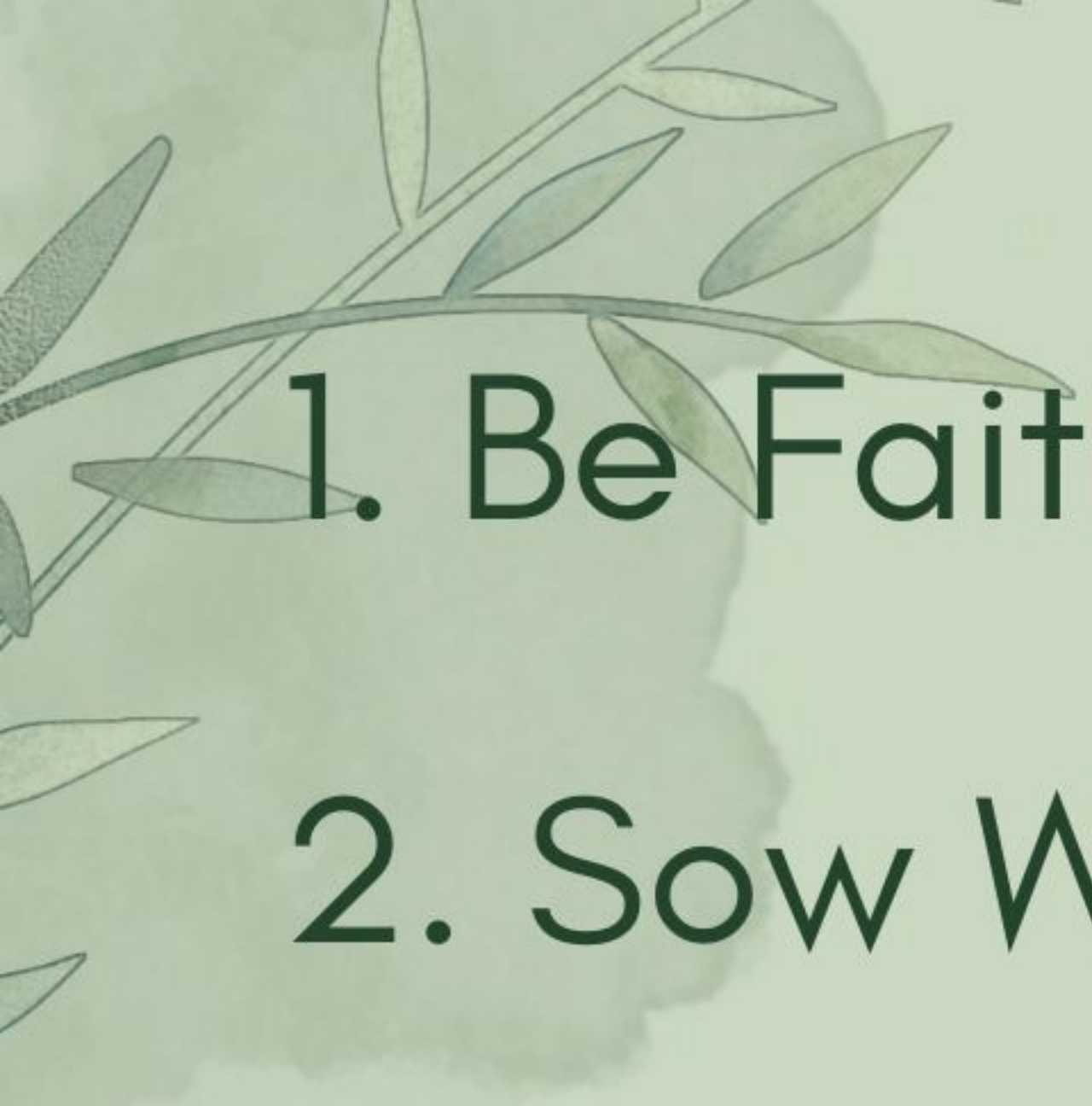
So neither he who plants nor He who waters is
