Luke 8:40-56

Luke 8:40

**Now when Jesus returned,
a crowd welcomed him, for
they were all expecting him.**

Luke 8:41-42

Then a man named Jairus, a synagogue leader, came and fell at Jesus' feet pleading with him to come to his house because his only daughter, a girl about twelve, was dying.

Luke 8:42-44

As Jesus was on his way, the crowds almost crushed him. And a woman was there who had been subject to bleeding for twelve years, but no one could heal her. She came up behind him and touched the edge of his cloak, and immediately her bleeding stopped.

Leviticus 15:25-27

If a woman has a flow of blood for many days that is unrelated to her menstrual period, or if the blood continues beyond the normal period, she is ceremonially unclean. As during her menstrual period, the woman will be unclean as long as the discharge continues. Any bed she lies on and any object she sits on during this time will be unclean, just as during her normal menstrual period. If you touch any of these things, you will be ceremonially unclean. You must wash your clothes and bathe yourself in water, and you will remain unclean until evening.

Luke 8:45

“Who touched me?

But Jesus said, “Someone touched me. I know that power has gone out from me.”

Then the woman seeing that she could not go unnoticed, came trembling and fell at his feet. In the presence of all the people she told why she had touched him and how she had been instantly healed.
