## Daniel 3:4-7

“Nations and peoples of every language, this is what you are commanded to do: As soon as you hear the sound of the horn, flute, zither, lyre, harp, pipe and all kinds of music, you must fall down and worship the image of gold that King Nebuchadnezzar has set up.”

**“Whoever does not fall down and worship will immediately be thrown into a blazing furnace.”**

**Therefore, as soon as they heard the sound of horn, flute, zither, lyre, harp and all kinds of music, all nations and peoples of every language fell down and worshiped the image of gold that King Nebuchadnezzar had set up.**

## Daniel 3:14-17

So these men were brought before the king, and Nebuchadnezzar said to them, “Is it true, Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, that you do not serve my gods or worship the image of gold I have set up?”

**“Now when you hear the sound of the horn, flute, zither, lyre, harp, pipe and all kinds of music, if you are ready to fall down and worship the image I made, very good. But if you do not worship it, you will be thrown immediately into the blazing furnace.”**

**“Then what god will  
be able to rescue you  
from my hand?”**

**Shadrach, Meshach  
and Abednego replied  
to him, “King  
Nebuchadnezzar, we  
do not need to defend  
ourselves before you  
in this matter.”**

**“If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God we serve is able to deliver us from it, and He will deliver us from your majesty’s hand.**

**But even if He does not, we want you to know, your majesty, that we will not serve your gods or worship the image of gold you have set up.”**

**Then Nebuchadnezzar was furious with Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, and his attitude towards them changed.**

**He ordered the furnace heated seven times hotter than usual and commanded some of the strongest soldiers in his army to tie up Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego and throw them into the blazing furnace.**

# Daniel 3:25

“Look! I see four men walking around in the fire, unbound and unharmed and the fourth looks like the son of the gods.”

## Daniel 3:27

They saw that the fire had not harmed their bodies, nor was a hair of their heads singed; their robes were not scorched and there was no smell of fire on them.

## Daniel 3:28-29

Then King Nebuchadnezzar said,  
“Praise be to the God of Shadrach,  
Meshach and Abednego who has  
sent his angel and rescued his  
servants! They trusted in Him and  
defied a king’s command and were  
willing to give up their lives rather  
than serve or worship any god  
except their own God.”

**“Therefore, I decree that the people of any nation or language who say anything against the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego be cut into pieces and their houses be turned into piles of rubble. For no other god can save in this way.”**
