


Luke 12:1 Meanwhile when a crowd of many thousands had gathered, so that they were trampling on one another, Jesus began to speak first to his disciples, saying; "Be on your guard against the yeast of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy."

- 1. Knowing the truth but not obeying it. 2. Living a self- serving life. 3. Reducing faith to rigid rules. 4. Outward conformity to the rules without inner transformation of the heart.

Luke 12:2-3

Ecclesiastes 12:14 For God will bring every deed into judgment, with every secret thing, whether good or evil.

1 Peter 5:7 Let your faith be bigger than your fear.

Luke 12: 6-7 Are not five sparrows sold for two pennies? Yet not one of them is forgotten by God. Indeed the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Don't be afraid, you are worth more than many sparrows.
