Luke 13:22-23 Then Jesus went through the towns and villages, teaching as he made his way to Jerusalem.

Someone asked him, "Lord, are only a few people going to be saved?"

Saved = Sozo

- 1. When people are being delivered / saved from demon possession.
- 2. When people are being physically or mentally healed.
 - 3. When talked about the forgiveness of sins. Being saved from our sins.

Luke 13:24 He said to them, "Make every effort to enter through the narrow door, because many, l tell, you will try to enter and will not be able to."

John 14:6 I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.

John 10:9 lam the gate; whoever enters through me will be saved.

Luke 13:25-27

Once the owner of the house gets up and closes the door, you will stand outside knocking and pleading, "Sir, open the door for us."

But He will answer, "I do not know you or where you come form."

Then you will say, "We ate and we drank with you, and you taught in our streets."
