Above all, my brothers and sisters, do not swear - not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. All you need to say is a simple "Yes" or "No", otherwise you will be condemned.

We should always speak honestly. Be a person of your word.

1 Peter 3:15-16 Instead, you must worship Christ as Lord of your life. And if someone asks about your hope as a believer, always be ready to explain it. But do this in a gentle and respectful way.

Keep your conscience clear. Then if people speak against you, they will be ashamed when they see what a good life you live because you belong to Christ.

Matthew 5:34-37 But I tell you, do not swear an oath at all; either by heaven, for it is God's throne, or by earth, for it is his footstool; or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the Great King.

And do not swear by your head, for you cannot make even one hair white or black. All you need to say is simply "Yes" or "No", anything beyond this comes from the evil one.

Luke 8:44 When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Psalm 34:13 Keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking deceit.

Let your yes be yes. Let your no be no. Anything else comes from the enemy.
