## 2 Corinthians 8:9

## Romans 6:1-4

## Matthew 11:28-30

Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly.”

## Mathew 6:1
