Ways Fear of Loneliness and Rejection can influence our lives

- Low self esteem
 People pleasing
 Clinginess or becoming overly reliant on others.
 Avoidance

- Hard time making decisions

1. Sometimes we are called to a time of loneliness.

a. A Time to grow deeper in relationship with God.

Jeremiah the Prophet

- Called as a teen
- Family turned against him.
- Whipped, attacked by a mob, put in stocks.
- Threatened by a king.
- Ridiculed.
- Beaten, arrested, accused of treason, and thrown in jail.
- Thrown into a cistern with the intention he would die.
- Completely alone.

Lamentations 3:22-25 Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for His mercies never fail. They are new every morning; Great is Your faithfulness. I say to myself, "The Lord is my portion; therefore I will wait for Him."

The Lord is good to those whose hope is in Him, to the one who seeks Him.

Jeremiah 29:11 "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

b. A time to prepare for what is next

Isaiah 55:8-9 "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the Lord. "As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts."

2. What we do in those seasons of loneliness or rejection matters.

Paul wrote Ephesians, Philippians, Colossians and Philemon while under Roman imprisonment.

Philippians 4:4-7 Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again- "Rejoice!" Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

3. Rejection comes with the package of following Jesus.

Matthew 24:9 You will be hated by all nations for my names sake.

John 15:18 If the world hates you, know that it has hated me before it hated you.

4. You're never really alone.

Joshua 1:9 Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go.

Genesis 16:13 "You are the God who sees me."

Ishmael = God will hear

Deuteronomy 31:8
