## THEME: Day Seven Sabbath Rest

## Scripture

Read, discuss, and memorize Genesis 2:1-3. Discuss the biblical principle of Sabbath. Read passages from Exodus, Deuteronomy, and Leviticus about God's command to keep the 7th day holy. Ask older students to do a word study on the word "Rest" and "Sabbath."

Review the seven days of creation. Read and discuss Genesis Chapter 2.

## Celebrate

This month celebrate! Take time to celebrate all you have accomplished and learned this school year. Take time to celebrate all that God has done for you and your family this school year. Take time to thank God for his many blessings and answered prayers this school year.

Host an End of the School Year Party. Invite your friends. Make snacks that represent each day of creation such as a veggie or fruit platter arranged in a rainbow, Oreo moon phase cookies, or ants on a log celery sticks. Read Genesis 1 and/or recite from memory Genesis 1. Spend time in worship together. Pick a few of your favorite songs that you sing at church on Sundays. Set up Days of Creation Experiment Stations. Replicate some of your favorite experiments for each day of creation. Host an Art Fair at your celebration. Ask each guest to bring their favorite art piece created this school year. Put them all on display. Host a poetry slam at your celebration. Invite guests to recite poetry they have memorized or composed this school year.

The idea is to take a much needed rest, to celebrate with friends, and to worship the Lord for his abundant gifts.
