#### Maintenance Committee Report

Your maintenance committee has been hard at work over the last month ensuring the club is kept in the best condition possible and it receives updates and additions that will lengthen its life while also enhancing our future revenues. As many of you may know, the club has experienced years of ongoing leaks in our front entrance and bathrooms that were repeatedly patched but would show up again and again. This year we had enough with throwing our money out on just another repair and

hired Coutney roofing who will finally put a new roof on these sections instead of simply another patch job which should be completed by the end of this month. As for the main hall roof, this was repaired by Max

Marienwald earlier in the month with metal sheets covering all areas of potential problems. Although this has most likely solved our current and near future possible leaks, in our future we are going to have to replace the entire roof and we are working on quotes for this expensive replacement. Many of you may also know of the past lack of hot water in the main hall bathrooms. This was quickly and inexpensively rectified with individual water heaters in both bathrooms which solved two problems. Not only did this solve the hot water issue but it also solved a problem we had with a leaking pipe in the floor as we could simply disconnect the pipe instead of tearing up the floor to repair it.
