Grant Application to Trillium Foundation for \$200k

As I am sure you all know the club buildings are deteriorating quickly and many major repairs and upgrades are required just so we can keep our doors open, and although we would like to complete these repairs and upgrades we simply don't have the money in the budget to do so. Previously to address the financing of these issues we have applied for Trillium grants in the hopes that the government would step in with a grant so we can get them done, with some years being successful and others not. This year with the seriousness of some of the repairs needed like the large hall roof and our heating and cooling, we decided to hire a professional grant writer to assist with the application to Trillium. Items that were quoted this year and applied for in the grant were:

Roof over main hall to be replaced and installation of a roof drains over dining room

Replace rooftop heating/cooling units with heat pumps for office and north entrance and hall, and dining room and east bathrooms

Replace roof top heating air conditioning unit for bar and east hall

New entrance doors and windows for east entrance. Doors will be wheelchair accessible


East entrance insulated and drywalled and painted east hallway to be painted and new ceiling tiles east bathrooms to be renovated like bathrooms off of main hall Cove room concrete block walls will be drywalled and painted

North entrance and hall concrete block walls to be drywalled and painted New parking lot drains to be in installed and gravel area will be resurfaced All of this would be at a cost of \$180,800 and this is what we have applied for in the Trillium grant. As the grant has a ceiling of \$200,000 we were not able to ap-

ply for anything additional at this time and therefor have left the north entrance and entrance and hall close to beer garden for the next grant.

As for the north entrance, we are looking at having it moved from its existing location to be closer to the office so when you enter the club you look into main hall not into wall of coat room wall. This would include new doors, windows (including wheelchair accessible doors), drywall, insulation, permanent wheelchair ramp.



German Language School London

Our 2023/2024 school year is slowly winding down and will conclude on June 1 with an Activity Day and Year-End Celebration at the German Club. This day will include student performances, fun games outside, and a BBQ on the patio.

Some of our students have been busy with exams over the last couple of months. Four of our High School Students took their DSD 1 exam in March and April. The DSD (Deutsches Sprachdiplom) is a non-compulsory examination for German secondary school students to certify their level of German. The DSD offers two diplomas, the DSD1 and DSD2, which certify different levels of German. These exams are held at more than 12,000 schools in 70 countries, with about 75,000 participants every year worldwide.

In Elementary School, our students have the opportunity to write the "Internationale schulische Vergleichsarbeiten" A1/A2 in preparation for the DSD, and eight Grade 4/5 students participate in the A1 test this year.

Walters (Walter) Robert (Bob) Hans 1937-2023

After a long battle, Bob Walters passed away at home on January 22, 2023 with his wife at his side. Predeceased by his mother Walburga, father Robert, brother Rudolf and sister Erika. He is survived by his wife Bibbi and her sister Soraya, daughter Susan, and family in Germany.

Bob immigrated from Germany to Canada in 1955. He was incredibly active in his community. An accomplished master electrician and real estate agent (Industrial and Commercial), he was president of the Marketing Division of the London and St. Thomas Real Estate Association (1972) and member of the London Chamber of Commerce. Being proud of his heritage, he was also active in the German Canadian Club of London, served on the Board of Directors and President (2005-2012). Bob also sang in the choir (bass section) and on the Board of Directors of the Lyra Chor, and so many others. Bob lived life fully and was passionate about travel, delicious food and great wine. One of his greatest achievements was part owner of the fine dining restaurant, Auberge du Careme (1975-1977). He was a very kind, compassionate and generous person. To those who knew him, Bob was a gentleman and a gentle man; truly loved and respected. He is greatly missed.

He was cremated at Needham Funeral service. At Bob's request, there was no public funeral.


