SECTION 4: First aid measures

4.1. Description of first aid measures

First-aid measures after inhalation : Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Keep warm and in a quiet

place. Place the victim in semi-seated position. Get medical advice/attention if you feel $\,$
