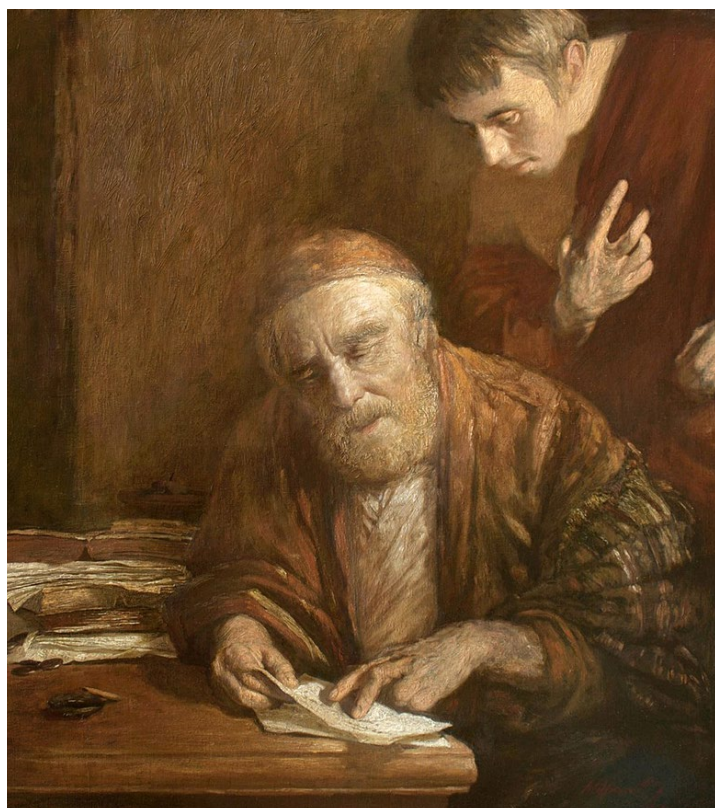

Dear St. Pancratius Family,

The Gospel this week teaches us about priorities: *"No servant can serve two masters... you cannot serve both God and mammon."* These are hard words to hear, because even if we faithfully attend Mass on Sundays, the Gospel invites us to reflect on the rest of our week: Who—or what—do we truly prioritize?

If we are honest, we often put our families, children's sports, careers, or the drive to climb higher in society at the top of the list. Sometimes it's the desire to make and save more money, or to have the next best thing in fashion or technology. None of these pursuits are bad in themselves—but if they take the place of faith in God, we risk becoming lost.

Faith in God must shape how we see money, possessions, and power. And how we spend the most precious gift of all—the gift of time—reveals whether we serve God or mammon.

Yes, the world will continue to challenge our priorities. But this Gospel asks us to step back and reflect: Who do we worship? Where do we pour our energy? How often do we give God first place? If the honest answer is that God has not been our priority, then the question becomes: what are we going to do about it?

This week, I invite you to take one concrete step: spend time with the Lord in prayer—whether that's quiet time at home, joining us for daily Mass, or stopping by for Eucharistic Adoration Monday or Friday. Make space for Him, and let that choice reorder your week around God. When we give Him the first place, everything else falls into its proper place.

Querida Familia de San Pancracio,

El Evangelio de esta semana nos enseña sobre prioridades: "No hay criado que pueda servir a dos amos... no pueden ustedes servir a Dios y al dinero." Son palabras difíciles de escuchar, porque incluso si asistimos fielmente a misa los domingos, el Evangelio nos invita a reflexionar sobre el resto de la semana: ¿A quién —o a qué— realmente priorizamos?

Siendo honestos, a menudo priorizamos a nuestra familia, el deporte de nuestros hijos, nuestra carrera profesional o el afán de ascender en la sociedad. A veces es el deseo de ganar y ahorrar más dinero, o de tener lo último en moda o tecnología. Ninguna de estas búsquedas es mala en sí misma, pero si reemplazan la fe en Dios, corremos el riesgo de perdernos.

La fe en Dios debe moldear nuestra visión del dinero, las posesiones y el poder. Y cómo gastamos el don máspreciado de todos —el don del tiempo— revela si servimos a Dios o a las riquezas.

Sí, el mundo seguirá cuestionando nuestras prioridades. Pero este Evangelio nos invita a detenernos y reflexionar: ¿A quién adoramos? ¿Dónde concentramos nuestra energía? ¿Con qué frecuencia le damos a Dios el primer lugar? Si la respuesta honesta es que Dios no ha sido nuestra prioridad, entonces la pregunta es: ¿qué vamos a hacer al respecto?

Esta semana, los invito a dar un paso concreto: pasar tiempo con el Señor en oración, ya sea un momento de tranquilidad en casa, acompañándonos a la misa diaria o asistiendo a la Adoración Eucarística los lunes o viernes. Hagan espacio para Él y permitan que esa decisión reorganice su semana en torno a Él. Cuando le damos el primer lugar, todo lo demás ocupa su lugar.
