Act against inappropriate images online

If a minor has had nude or explicit images or videos published on the internet, there is assistance to remove those images online. Take It Down is a free service provided by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children (NCMEC) that helps to stop the sharing of explicit images taken of victims under the age of 18. Users can remain anonymous, and do not have to send or share their images to anyone. Take It Down uses public, unencrypted online platforms to remove these images from the internet. Los usuarios del servicio pueden mantener el anonimato y no tienen que enviar ni compartir sus imágenes con nadie. Dear St. Pancratius Family,

If you have been wondering what the fencing in front of the garage is all about, we are preparing for the delivery of our long-awaited sanctuary furnishings from Spain. Many of the pieces are scheduled to arrive on Monday, with some of the larger items arriving at a later date.

As we receive and install these sacred furnishings, we are determining how the work will affect the availability of the church in the coming weeks. This may impact where we celebrate Mass and hold our daily periods of Adoration. As soon as the schedule is finalized, we will announce any necessary changes.

This transition period also provides us with a wonderful opportunity to focus not only on renewing the physical beauty of our church, but also on renewing our interior spiritual lives. One area we will be emphasizing is a greater intentionality toward silence before and after Mass, as well as during times of Eucharistic Adoration.

The church is not simply a gathering hall; it is the house of God, the place where Our Lord dwells among us in the Blessed Sacrament. As such, it should be a place that fosters prayer, reverence, and sacred silence.

To support this effort, we will be asking our musicians and choir members to help cultivate a more prayerful atmosphere before and after Mass by allowing time for quiet preparation before the liturgy and thanksgiving afterward. During Eucharistic Adoration, we will also incorporate more dedicated periods of silence. Additionally, we are developing opportunities for communal prayer in Spanish. These schedules are currently being drafted and will likely take effect in August.

As we beautify what is visible within our church, may we also allow God to beautify what is within our hearts.

St. Teresa of Calcutta famously said:

"We need to find God, and He cannot be found in noise and restlessness. God is the friend of silence. See how nature—trees, flowers, grass—grows in silence; see the stars, the moon, and the sun, how they move in silence. We need silence.

Estimada familia de San Pancracio:

Si se han preguntado a qué se debe la valla frente al garaje, les informo que nos estamos preparando para recibir el mobiliario del santuario, largamente esperado, proveniente de España. La llegada de muchas de las piezas está programada para el lunes, mientras que algunos de los artículos más grandes llegarán en una fecha posterior.

A medida que recibimos e instalamos este mobiliario sagrado, estamos evaluando cómo los trabajos afectarán la disponibilidad del templo en las próximas semanas. Esto podría influir en el lugar donde celebramos la Misa y llevamos a cabo nuestros momentos diarios de Adoración. Tan pronto como se defina el horario, anunciaremos cualquier cambio necesario.

Este periodo de transición también nos brinda una oportunidad maravillosa para centrarnos no solo en renovar la belleza física de nuestro templo, sino también en renovar nuestra vida espiritual interior. Un aspecto que queremos destacar es la importancia de mantener el silencio de manera intencional antes y después de cada Misa, así como durante los momentos de Adoración Eucarística.

La iglesia no es simplemente un lugar de reunión; es la casa de Dios, el lugar donde Nuestro Señor habita entre nosotros en el Santísimo Sacramento. Por ello, debe ser un espacio que fomente la oración, la reverencia y el silencio sagrado.

Para apoyar este esfuerzo, pediremos a nuestros músicos y miembros del coro que ayuden a crear un ambiente más propicio para la oración antes y después de la Misa, permitiendo momentos de preparación silenciosa previa a la liturgia y de acción de gracias al finalizar. Durante la Adoración Eucarística, también incorporaremos más periodos dedicados al silencio por completo. Además, estamos organizando espacios para la oración comunitaria en español. Estos horarios se están elaborando y es probable que entren en vigor en agosto.

Mientras embellecemos lo visible en nuestra iglesia, permitamos también que Dios embellezca nuestro interior.

Santa Teresa de Calcuta dijo célebremente:

"Necesitamos encontrar a Dios, y Él no puede ser hallado en el ruido y la inquietud. Dios es amigo del silencio. Miren cómo la naturaleza —los árboles, las flores, el césped— crece en silencio; observen las estrellas, la luna y el sol, cómo se mueven en silencio. Necesitamos el silencio".
