En tiempos de crisis, leer libros puede ayudar a los niños a comprender la situación y encontrar consuelo

La respuesta de los padres ante una crisis puede influir significativamente en la reacción de los hijos. Leer libros y cuentos puede ayudar a los padres a ofrecer entendimiento y consuelo a sus hijos durante momentos difíciles. El libro "Trinka y Juan: el gran fuego" se puede descargar en línea en inglés y español de parte de la Red Nacional para el Estrés Traumático Infantil (The National Child Traumatic Stress Network). El libro ayuda a los niños pequeños y a sus familias hablar sobre los sentimientos y las preocupaciones que pueden tener después de un gran incendio. En la parte final del libro hay una guía que ofrece a los padres diferentes maneras de usar el cuento con sus hijos. In the Gospel today, Jesus gives us the blessings of serving the poor, hungry and weeping people, for you will then rejoice and leap for joy. But Jesus also teaches us the decisiveness of choice: blessing or woe.



Choosing to help those who are suffering will fill your heart with the blessing of Jesus and indeed your reward will be great in heaven.

Dear St. Pancratius Family,

Following what has become a little mini series on approaching the sacraments and my last bulletin letter on etiquette during mass, I wanted to write this week on proper etiquette in receiving communion. This is an important topic to visit because due to the pandemic, some customs in receiving communion were put on hold and have only made an erratic return. The manner in which we approach the Eucharist should witness to our belief that the Eucharist is the true presence of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

Before Mass. It is important to be conscious of any grave sin. If we have committed any mortal sin, we should avoid receiving communion. To receive communion in a state of mortal sin is in and of itself a grave sin. This is stated both in scripture and the catechism. It is also important to fast for one hour before receiving communion. Water and medicine are exceptions to the fast.

During Mass. Pay attention to the prayers of the Liturgy of the Eucharist. They help prepare our hearts to receive Christ sacramentally. When it is time to approach the minister to receive, it is important that we approach with reverence. As the person in front receives, we should make a gesture of reverence by either bowing or genuflection. For those who receive kneeling, that counts as your gesture of reverence. The communicant has every right to receive either kneeling or standing, on the tongue or on the hand. As a priest, we do not have the right to tell you how to receive, insofar as it is reverent. When the minister says "Body of Christ," the communicant should respond "Amen." The communicant should not say "Thank you." The amen is a declaration of belief that the Eucharist is indeed the Body of Christ. If receiving on the hand, hands should be cleared of all items and sleeves should be pulled back away from the palms. The Eucharist should also be consumed in front of the minister. The communicant should never try to take the Eucharist from the hands of the minister, but should allow for the minister to place it on their palm. Upon returning to our seats, we should give God a short prayer of thanks.

This is a straightforward letter on proper etiquette in receiving communion. I hope you find it helpful in receiving all the grace God has to offer in the sacrament of the Eucharist.

Querida familia de San Pancracio:

Después de lo que se ha convertido en una pequeña miniserie sobre cómo acercarse a los sacramentos y mi última carta para el boletín sobre las normas adecuadas durante la misa, quería escribir esta semana sobre las normas adecuadas para recibir la comunión. Este es un tema importante para tratar porque debido a la pandemia, algunas costumbres para recibir la comunión se suspendieron y solo han regresado de manera errática. La forma en que nos acercamos a la Eucaristía debe dar testimonio de nuestra creencia de que la Eucaristía es la verdadera presencia del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Jesucristo.


Antes de la Misa. Es importante ser conscientes de cualquier pecado grave. Si hemos cometido algún pecado mortal, debemos evitar recibir la comunión. Recibir la comunión en estado de pecado mortal es en sí mismo un pecado grave. Esto se afirma tanto en las Escrituras como en el catecismo. También es importante ayunar durante una hora antes de recibir la comunión. El agua y los medicamentos son excepciones al ayuno.

Durante la Misa. Preste atención a las oraciones de la Liturgia de la Eucaristía. Estas ayudan a preparar nuestros corazones para recibir a Cristo sacramentalmente. Cuando llega el momento de acercarnos al ministro, es importante que nos acerquemos con reverencia. Cuando la persona que está delante recibe la Eucaristía, debemos hacer un gesto de reverencia, ya sea inclinando la cabeza o haciendo una genuflexión. Para aquellos que reciben de rodillas, eso cuenta como un gesto de reverencia. El comulgante tiene todo el derecho de recibir de rodillas o de pie, en la lengua o en la mano. Como sacerdotes, no tenemos derecho a decirle cómo recibir, siempre y cuando sea de forma reverente. Cuando el ministro dice "Cuerpo de Cristo", el comulgante debe responder "Amén". El comulgante no debe decir "Gracias". El amén es una declaración de creencia de que la Eucaristía es de hecho el Cuerpo de Cristo. Si se recibe en la mano, las manos deben estar limpias de todo objeto y las mangas deben estar alejadas de las palmas. La Eucaristía también debe consumirse frente al ministro. El comulgante nunca debe intentar tomar la Eucaristía de las manos del ministro, sino que debe permitir que el ministro la coloque en su palma. Al regresar a nuestros asientos, debemos ofrecer a Dios una breve oración de agradecimiento.

Esta es una carta sencilla sobre las normas adecuadas para recibir la comunión. Espero que le resulte útil para recibir toda la gracia que Dios tiene para ofrecer en el sacramento de la Eucaristía.


