Dear St. Pancratius Family,

This Sunday is known as "Good Shepherd Sunday," and the beautiful parable of the Good Shepherd carries consoling truths and promises for every age — including our own.

Today's Gospel rings with a staggering and consoling claim: "I am the good shepherd. I know my sheep and mine know me" (Jn 10:14). The God of the universe knows each of us by name and calls us to follow Him. Christ's sheepfold is the Church. In the Church He bestows on us His life in the Sacraments, His word in her teaching, and all the riches of His grace to light our way as we go forward to our heavenly home.

In our distracted age, it is easy to tune out the Shepherd's voice. But the readings this week make one thing plain: Someone is calling. God has not stopped calling — it is we who have allowed ourselves to be distracted by worldly concerns constantly begging for our attention.

This Sunday is also commonly known as Vocation Sunday. On this day we are especially asked to pray that the Church may be provided with the leaders needed to do its work of spreading the Gospel.

While we often put a lot of focus on those called to the priesthood, this day is also a reminder of our various vocations — be it priesthood or consecrated life, as well as those of the laity in our diverse callings in life.

How you can respond:

- Pray daily for vocations — in your home, at Mass, and in quiet moments of silence.
- Speak to just one young person you know this week and encourage them to think about a possible vocation to the priesthood, permanent diaconate, or consecrated life.
- Listen for where the Shepherd is calling you — every Christian has a vocation to love and serve.

Querida familia de San Pancracio:

Este domingo se conoce como el "Domingo del Buen Pastor", y la hermosa parábola del Buen Pastor encierra verdades y promesas reconfortantes para todas las épocas, incluida la nuestra.

El Evangelio de hoy resuena con una afirmación asombrosa y consoladora: "Yo soy el buen pastor; conozco a mis ovejas y las mías me conocen" (Jn 10:14). El Dios del universo nos conoce a cada uno por nuestro nombre y nos llama a seguirlo. El redil de Cristo es la Iglesia. En la Iglesia, Él nos concede su vida en los Sacramentos, su palabra en su enseñanza y todas las riquezas de su gracia para iluminar nuestro camino hacia nuestro hogar celestial.

En nuestra época de distracciones, es fácil ignorar la voz del Pastor. Pero las lecturas de esta semana dejan algo claro: Alguien nos llama. Dios no ha dejado de llamar; somos nosotros quienes nos hemos dejado distraer por las preocupaciones mundanas que constantemente reclaman nuestra atención.

Este domingo también se conoce comúnmente como el Domingo de las Vocaciones. En este día, se nos pide especialmente que oremos para que la Iglesia cuente con los líderes necesarios para llevar a cabo su labor de difundir el Evangelio.

Si bien solemos centrarnos en quienes tienen vocación sacerdotal, este día también nos recuerda nuestras diversas vocaciones, ya sea al sacerdocio o a la vida consagrada, así como las de los laicos en sus diferentes vocaciones en la vida.

Cómo puedes responder:

- Ora diariamente por las vocaciones: en tu hogar, en la Misa y en momentos de silencio.
- Habla con un joven que conozcas esta semana y animale a considerar una posible vocación al sacerdocio, al diaconado permanente o a la vida consagrada.
- Escucha la voz del Pastor para saber a dónde te llama: todo cristiano tiene una vocación de amar y servir.

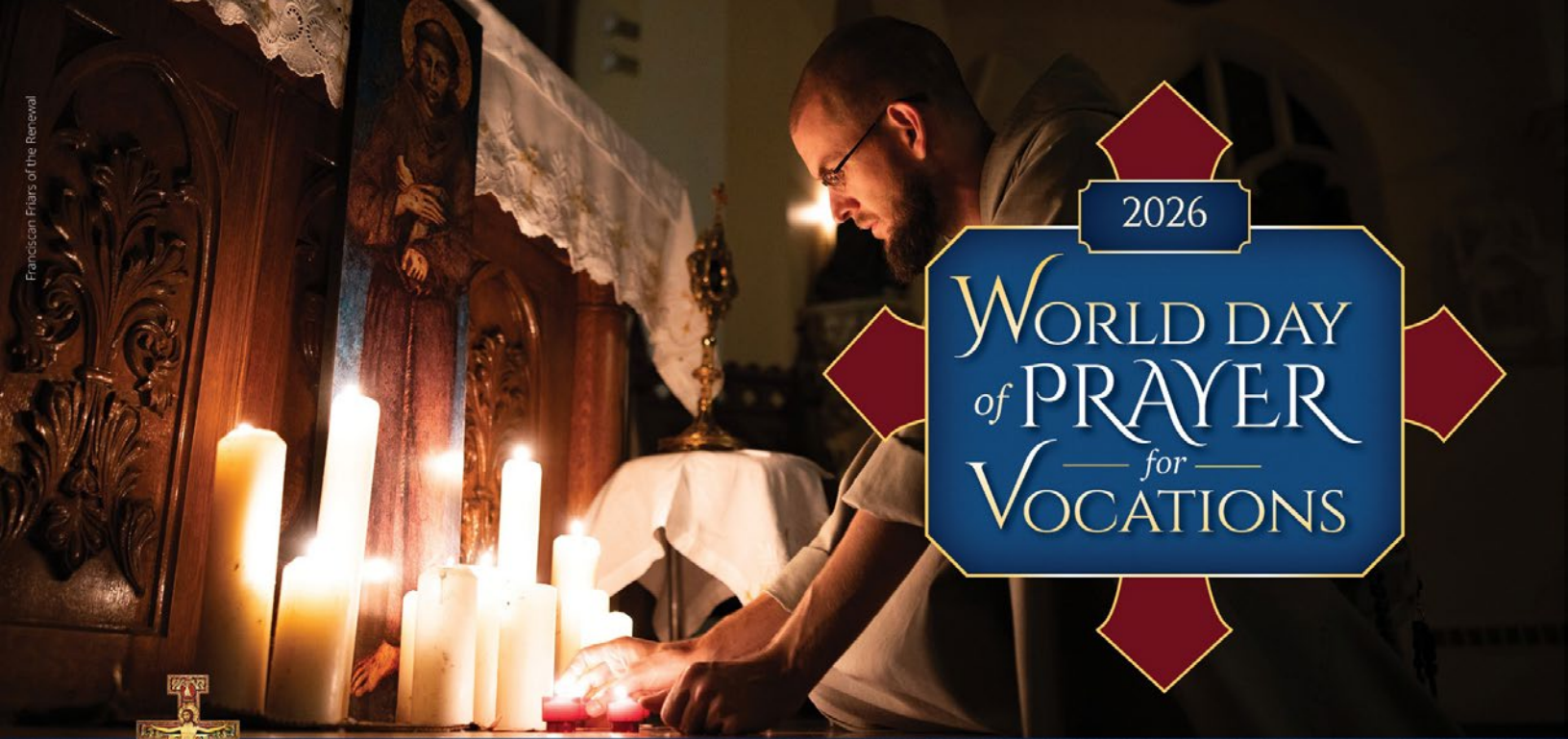

Jesus Christ revealed to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque the "**Nine First Fridays**" devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This involves the practice of receiving Holy Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays of the month in reparation to "the heart that has loved men so and is loved so little in return. (Christ own words to St. Margaret Mary).

The reparation consists of:

1. Receiving Holy Communion on each First Friday of the month.
2. Completing the Nine First Fridays in nine consecutive months.
3. Making the Nine First Fridays in honor of and in reparation to Our Lord's Most Sacred Heart for all the blasphemies, outrages, sacrileges and indifferences committed against it.



Our Lady of Fatima requested the practice of making reparation for sins of blasphemy and ingratitude against her Immaculate Heart on the **First Saturday of five consecutive months.**

This reparation consists of:

1. Confession (20 days before or after)
2. Receive Holy Communion.
3. Recite five decades of the Rosary.
4. Keep the Blessed Mother company meditating for a quarter of an hour on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary.
