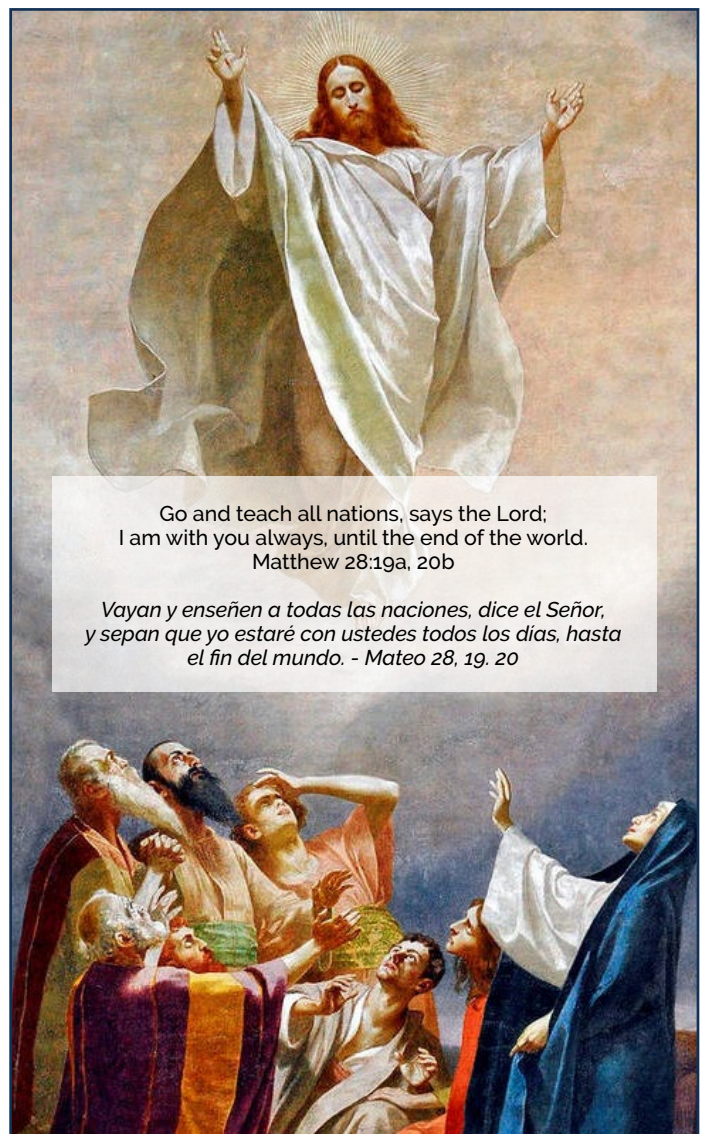

Concerning behaviors in children could indicate abuse

Some concerning behaviors that go beyond natural curiosity, could be signs of sexual abuse. These behaviors include asking a peer or adult to engage in a specific act, inserting objects into private areas, explicit imitation of intercourse, and behaviors that are persistent and resistant to distraction. Any of these signs could indicate that a child is being abused or exposed to sexually inappropriate behavior. These efforts are only possible because of your generosity and your faithful prayers. Thank you.

Adding to the joy of this weekend, our parish teens will be receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation from Bishop Marc, completing their journey of initiation into the Church. It is a beautiful culmination of our sacramental season, and we now look forward to a brief time of rest before beginning formation anew in the fall.

There is so much to be grateful for — new vocations, growing faith, a vibrant parish life, and a community that continues to walk together in Christ. We are blessed because YOU are family to us!

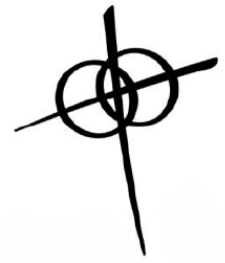
Pilgrim Image of Fatima

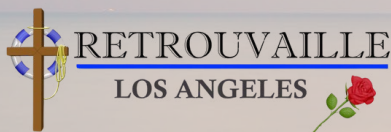
