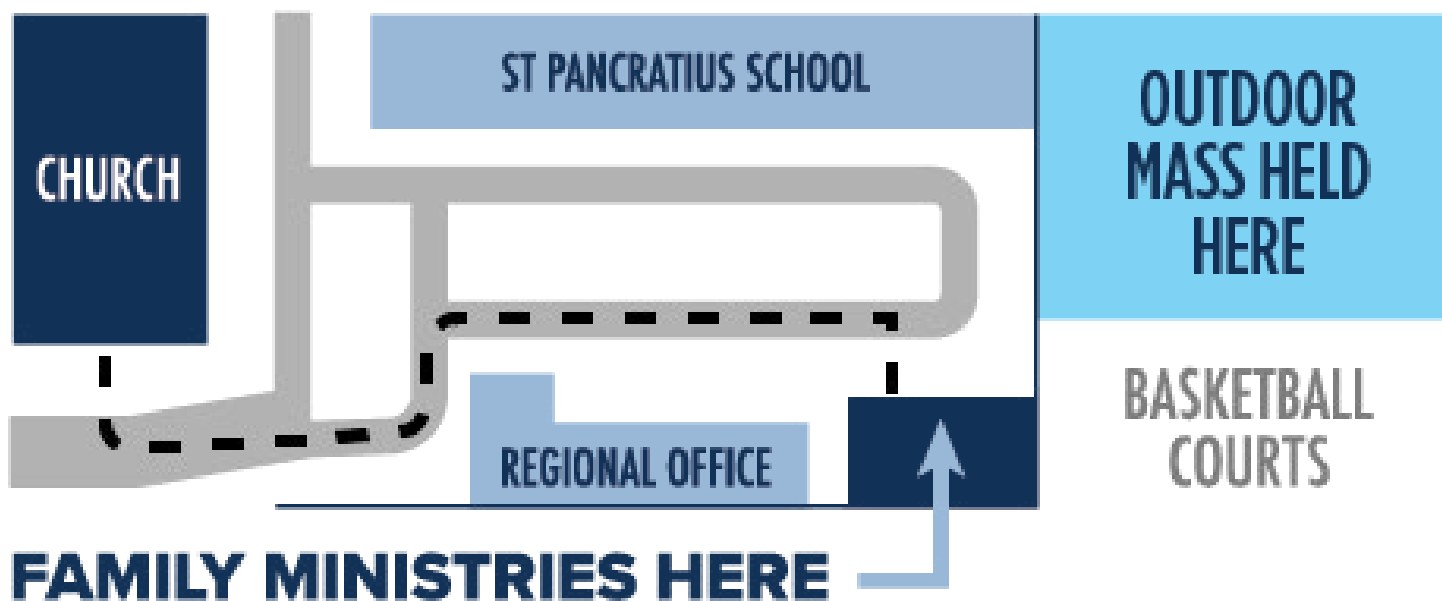

*El 24 de junio de 2026, dos potentes terremotos sacudieron Venezuela a unas 100 millas al oeste de Caracas, dejando tras de sí una devastación generalizada y una crisis humanitaria en desarrollo. Barrios enteros han quedado reducidos a escombros, viviendas y escuelas se han derumbado, hospitales e infraestructuras esenciales han sufrido graves daños y miles de familias han sido desplazadas. Los equipos de rescate continúan buscando supervivientes mientras las réplicas dificultan las labores de recuperación, al tiempo que innumerables familias carecen de refugio seguro, agua potable, alimentos, atención médica o electricidad.*
