Querida familia de San Pancracio:

Al encontrarnos en el tiempo litúrgico ordinario, tenemos dos domingos especiales para celebrar: este fin de semana es la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad, y la próxima semana será la del Corpus Christi. El tiempo pascual concluyó con la celebración de Pentecostés.

Al adentrarnos en el fin de semana de la Santísima Trinidad, celebramos una solemnidad que nos recuerda que Dios es Tres en Uno. Dios es relación: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. En los últimos días, hemos perdido a algunos amigos y feligreses de San Pancracio. Que sus almas descansen en paz. Les pedimos, asimismo, que tengan presentes en sus oraciones durante esta semana a sus familias —nuestra propia familia parroquial.

St. Pancratius Church will be launching a monthly, 12-session Bible study series for men in June. All men of the parish are invited to attend.

Into the Breach is a 12-episode video series and study guide developed by the Knights of Columbus, inspired by Bishop Thomas J. The series covers themes like masculinity, brotherhood, leadership, fatherhood, prayer, and the sacraments.

Jesus Christ revealed to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque the **"Nine First Fridays"** devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This involves the practice of receiving Holy Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays of the month in reparation to "the heart that has loved men so and is loved so little in return. (Christ own words to St. Margaret Mary).

The reparation consists of:

1. Receiving Holy Communion on each First Friday of the month.
2. Completing the Nine First Fridays in nine consecutive months.
3. Making the Nine First Fridays in honor of and in reparation to Our Lord's Most Sacred Heart for all the blasphemies, outrages, sacrileges and indifferences committed against it.



Our Lady of Fatima requested the practice of making reparation for sins of blasphemy and ingratitude against her Immaculate Heart on the **First Saturday of five consecutive months.**

This reparation consists of:

1. Confession (20 days before or after)
2. Receive Holy Communion.
3. Recite five decades of the Rosary.
4. Keep the Blessed Mother company meditating for a quarter of an hour on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary.

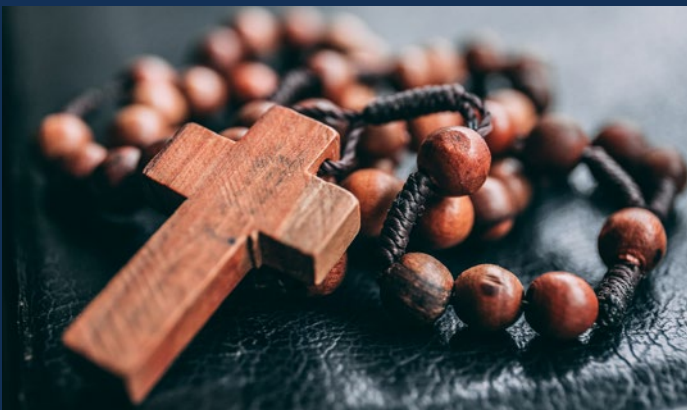


Pilgrim Guadalupe
