Dear St. Pancratius Family,

Fifty days after the Resurrection, Jesus keeps His promise. The Church celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the first disciples gathered in Jerusalem—the moment when the fearful followers of Jesus were strengthened to proclaim the gospel boldly to the world.

The apostles were gathered in Jerusalem when a sound like a mighty wind filled the house, and "tongues as of fire" appeared and rested on each of them. Filled with the Holy Spirit, they began to speak in different languages, proclaiming the mighty works of God to Jews from many nations who had gathered in the city. That day, three thousand were baptized. The Church was born. But Pentecost is not merely history, it is an ongoing reality. The same Spirit who descended in wind and flame seeks to renew your heart today.

The same Holy Spirit who descended on the apostles continues to guide the Church, sanctify the faithful, and strengthen Christians to proclaim Jesus Christ. The Christian life cannot be lived by human effort alone. We need grace. We need courage. We need the Holy Spirit to renew our hearts and purify our desires.

After the Epistle or Second Reading of the Mass, the ancient Sequence *Veni, Sancte Spiritus* (Come, Holy Spirit) is recited or sung. Let these words penetrate your soul. Ask the Spirit to open the borders of your heart—to break through your fears, your isolation, your resistance to His transforming fire.

On Pentecost 2026, Catholics celebrate the Spirit who gave birth to the Church's public mission and who continues to renew the face of the earth.

Do not leave this Mass unchanged. Come before the Lord in expectation. The fire awaits.

Come, Holy Spirit. Fill the hearts of your faithful. Enkindle in them the fire of your love.

Querida familia de San Pancracio:

Cincuenta días después de la Resurrección, Jesús cumple su promesa. La Iglesia celebra el descenso del Espíritu Santo sobre los apóstoles, la Santísima Virgen María y los primeros discípulos reunidos en Jerusalén: el momento en que los temerosos seguidores de Jesús fueron fortalecidos para proclamar el Evangelio con valentía al mundo.

Los apóstoles estaban reunidos en Jerusalén cuando un sonido semejante al de un viento impetuoso llenó la casa, y aparecieron "lenguas como de fuego" que se posaron sobre cada uno de ellos. Llenos del Espíritu Santo, comenzaron a hablar en diferentes idiomas, proclamando las obras grandiosas de Dios a judíos de muchas naciones que se habían congregado en la ciudad. Ese día, tres mil personas fueron bautizadas. Nació la Iglesia. Pero Pentecostés no es meramente historia; es una realidad continua. El mismo Espíritu que descendió en forma de viento y fuego busca renovar tu corazón hoy.

El mismo Espíritu Santo que descendió sobre los apóstoles continúa guiando a la Iglesia, santificando a los fieles y fortaleciendo a los cristianos para proclamar a Jesucristo. La vida cristiana no puede vivirse únicamente mediante el esfuerzo humano. Necesitamos la gracia. Necesitamos valentía. Necesitamos al Espíritu Santo para renovar nuestros corazones y purificar nuestros deseos.

Después de la Epístola o Segunda Lectura de la Misa, se recita o se canta la antigua Secuencia *Veni, Sancte Spiritus* (Ven, Espíritu Santo). Permite que estas palabras penetren en tu alma. Pide al Espíritu que abra las fronteras de tu corazón; que derribe tus miedos, tu aislamiento y tu resistencia a su fuego transformador.

En el Pentecostés de 2026, los católicos celebran al Espíritu que dio origen a la misión pública de la Iglesia y que continúa renovando la faz de la tierra. No salgas de esta Misa sin haber cambiado. Preséntate ante el Señor con expectación. El fuego te aguarda.

Ven, Espíritu Santo. Llena los corazones de tus fieles. Enciende en ellos el fuego de tu amor.

You won't need to travel far for Mass! Attend the Saturday vigil Mass or on Sunday morning.

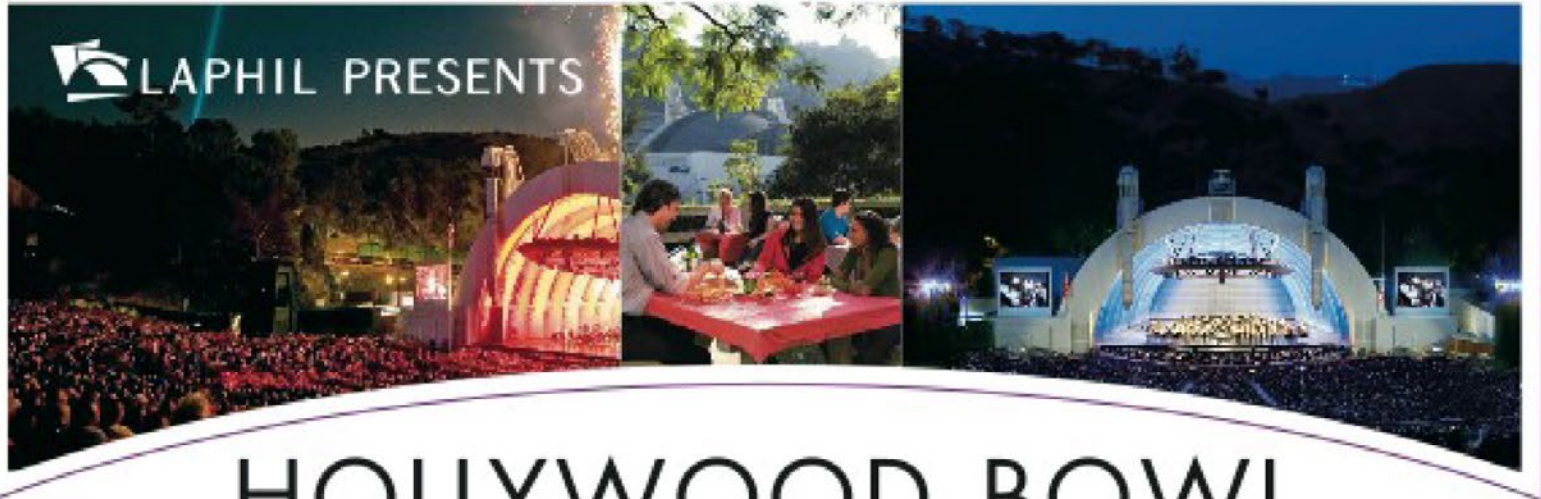
