

Adults must also be willing to look at their own behavior and ensure that it is aligned with safety policies and practices. Monitoring the behavior of all adults and speaking up if something is uncomfortable or unsettling — no matter what the relationship between the adults is — it's critical to keeping children safe. Jesus Christ revealed to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque the "Nine First Fridays" devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. This involves the practice of receiving Holy Communion on nine consecutive First Fridays of the month in reparation to "the heart that has loved men so and is loved so little in return. (Christ own words to St. Margaret Mary).

#### The reparation consists of:

- 1. Receiving Holy Communion on each First Friday of the month.
- 2. Completing the Nine First Fridays in nine consecutive months.
- Making the Nine First Fridays in honor of and in reparation to Our Lord's Most Scared Heart for all the blasphemies, outrages, sacrileges and indifferences committed against it.



Our Lady of Fatima requested the practice of making reparation for sins of blasphemy and ingratitude against her Immaculate Heart on the First Saturday of five consecutive months.

#### This reparation consists of:

- 1. Confession (20 days before or after)
- 2. Receive Holy Communion.
- 3. Recite five decades of the Rosary.
- 4. Keep the Blessed Mother company meditating for a quarter of an hour on the fifteen mysteries of the Rosary.


