Today, we celebrate "Good Shepherd Sunday" where we reflect on Jesus' care and love of us.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Today is the Fourth Sunday of the Easter Season, also known as Good Shepherd Sunday. This is because in the Gospel today Jesus compares himself to a shepherd who **"calls his own sheep by name and leads them out (of the sheepfold) ... he walks ahead of them, and the sheep follow him, because they recognize his voice."** (Jn. 10:3b-4) Jesus, as our shepherd, doesn't drive us by force, but leads us and we follow him because we recognize his voice, and we know it is a voice we can trust. We're all familiar with Psalm 23 which says, **"The Lord is my shepherd. There is nothing I shall want. Fresh and green are the pastures, where he gives me repose. Near restful waters he leads me and revives my drooping spirit...Even though I walk through the dark valley, I fear no evil for you are at my side."**

In life we put our trust in different people who have the responsibility to care for us. If they should fail us in some way, our trust is broken. By his death on the cross, Jesus has proven himself completely trustworthy and someone on whom we can always depend. He saved our lives from the deadly clutches of the wolf, who is Satan, by allowing himself to be destroyed on the cross. Jesus then destroys the power of Satan and death by his own power to take his life up again in the resurrection, in union with his Father's command (John 10:18) In every Mass we attend, let us continue to hear his voice, to witness him laying his life down and taking it up again on the altar, to consume him in holy communion, and to find rest for our souls in him.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

*Hoy es el cuarto domingo del tiempo pascual, que también se conoce como el Domingo del Buen Pastor. Esto se debe a que en el Evangelio de hoy Jesús se compara con un pastor que **"llama a sus ovejas por su nombre y las saca (del redil) ... él camina delante de ellas, y las ovejas lo siguen, porque reconocen su voz."** (Juan 10:3b-4) Jesús, como nuestro pastor, no nos impulsa por la fuerza, sino que nos guía y lo seguimos porque reconocemos su voz y sabemos que es una voz en la que podemos confiar. Todos estamos familiarizados con el Salmo 23 que dice, **"El Señor es mi pastor, nada me faltará. Frescos y verdes son los pastos donde él me da descanso. Cerca de aguas reparadoras él me guía y reaviva mi espíritu abatido ... Aunque camine en el valle oscuro, no temeré porque tu estás a mi lado."***

En la vida, ponemos nuestra confianza en diferentes personas que tienen la responsabilidad de cuidarnos. Si nos fallan de alguna manera, nuestra confianza se rompe. Por su muerte en la cruz, Jesús ha demostrado ser completamente digno de confianza y alguien en quien siempre podemos confiar. El salvó nuestras vidas de las garras mortales de Satanás al permitirse ser destruido en la cruz. Pero luego Jesús destruye el poder de Satanás y la muerte por su propio poder para retomar su vida en su resurrección, en unión con el mandato de su Padre. (Juan 10:18) En cada misa que asistimos, déjanos seguir escuchando su voz, siendo testigos de como entrega su vida y la recoge por nosotros en el altar, consumiéndolo en la sagrada comunión, y encontrando descanso para nuestras almas en él.
